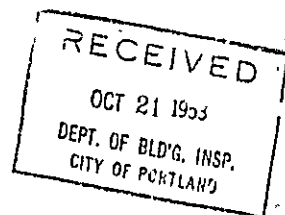

Plumbing
Check and have repaired all defective plumbing and plumbing fixtures throughout the apartment.
a) Repair or replace the defective sink strainer in the kitchen of the first floor apartment.

Structural Repairs
Repair or replace and put in good order all dilapidated and hazardous parts of the structure as follows:
a) Repair or replace the loose, cracked, or missing plaster on the ceiling of the kitchen and living room in the first floor apartment.
b) Putty the loose window panes in all the windows throughout the first floor apartment.
c) Replace the broken cellar windows.

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of the City Ordinance "Minimum Standards for Continued Occupancy" and must be corrected on or before November 20, 1953.
