Dear Sir:

Your application to change the use of 115 Clark St. from one to three families has been reviewed and a building permit is herewith issued subject to the following requirements.

1. Each unit (apartment shall have access to two (2) separate, remote and approved exits.
2. All vertical openings (stairways shall be enclosed with construction), having a fire rating of at least 30 min. including fire doors with self-closers.
3. The boiler room shall be enclosed with construction having a fire rating of at least (1) one hour including ceiling and fire door with self-closer.
4. 1716.3.4 Dwelling units: A minimum of one single station smoke detector shall be installed in each guest room suite or sleeping area in buildings of Use Group R-1 and in dwelling units within buildings of Use Groups R-2 or R-3. It shall be installed in a manner and location approved by the authority having jurisdiction. When actuated, the detector shall provide an alarm suitable to warn the occupants within the individual unit (see Section 1717.3.1). In buildings having basements or cellars an additional smoke detector shall be installed in the basement or cellar in a location approved by the authority having jurisdiction.
5. 809.4 Emergency escape: Every sleeping room below the fourth story in buildings of use Group R shall have at least one operable window or exterior door approved for emergency egress or rescue. The units must be operable from the inside opening without the use of separate tools.

Where windows are provided as a means of egress or rescue, they shall have a sill height not more than 44 inches (1118mm) above the floor. All egress or rescue windows from sleeping rooms must have a minimum net clear opening of 5.7 square feet (0.53m²). The minimum net clear opening height dimension shall be 24 inches (610mm). The minimum net clear opening width dimension shall be 20 inches (508mm).

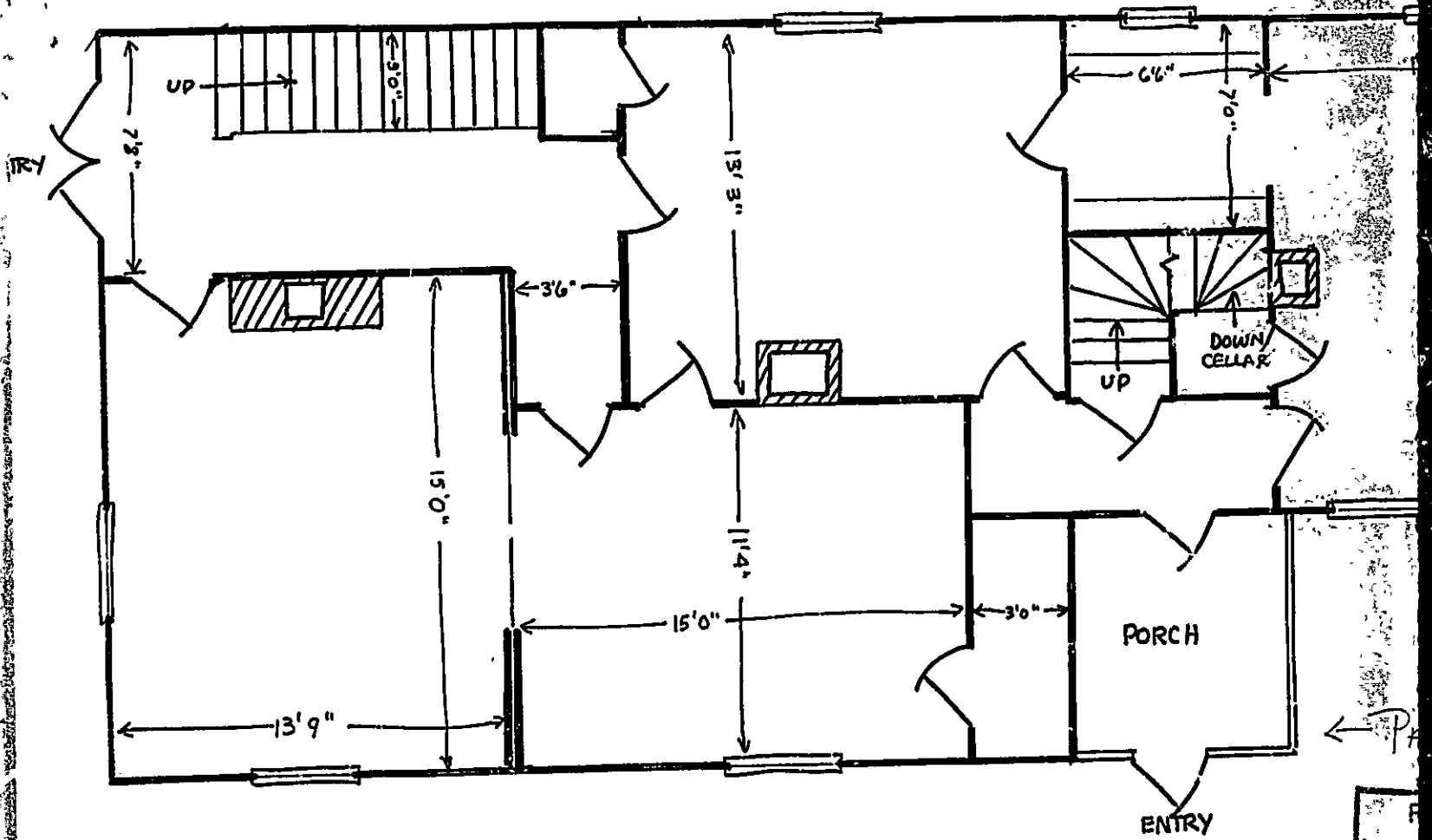
Bars, grilles or screens placed over emergency escape windows shall be releasable or removable from the inside without the use of a key tool or excessive force.

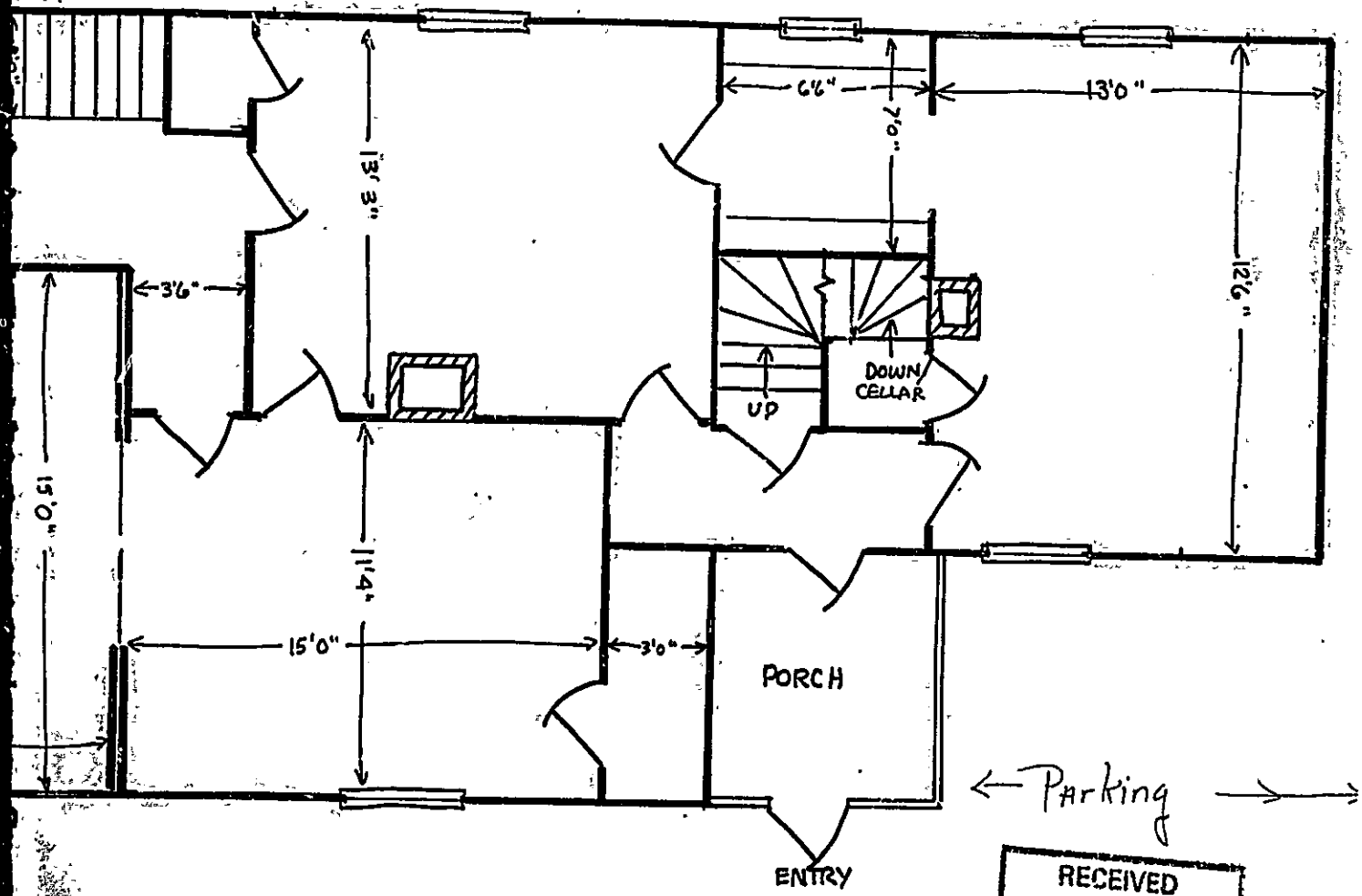

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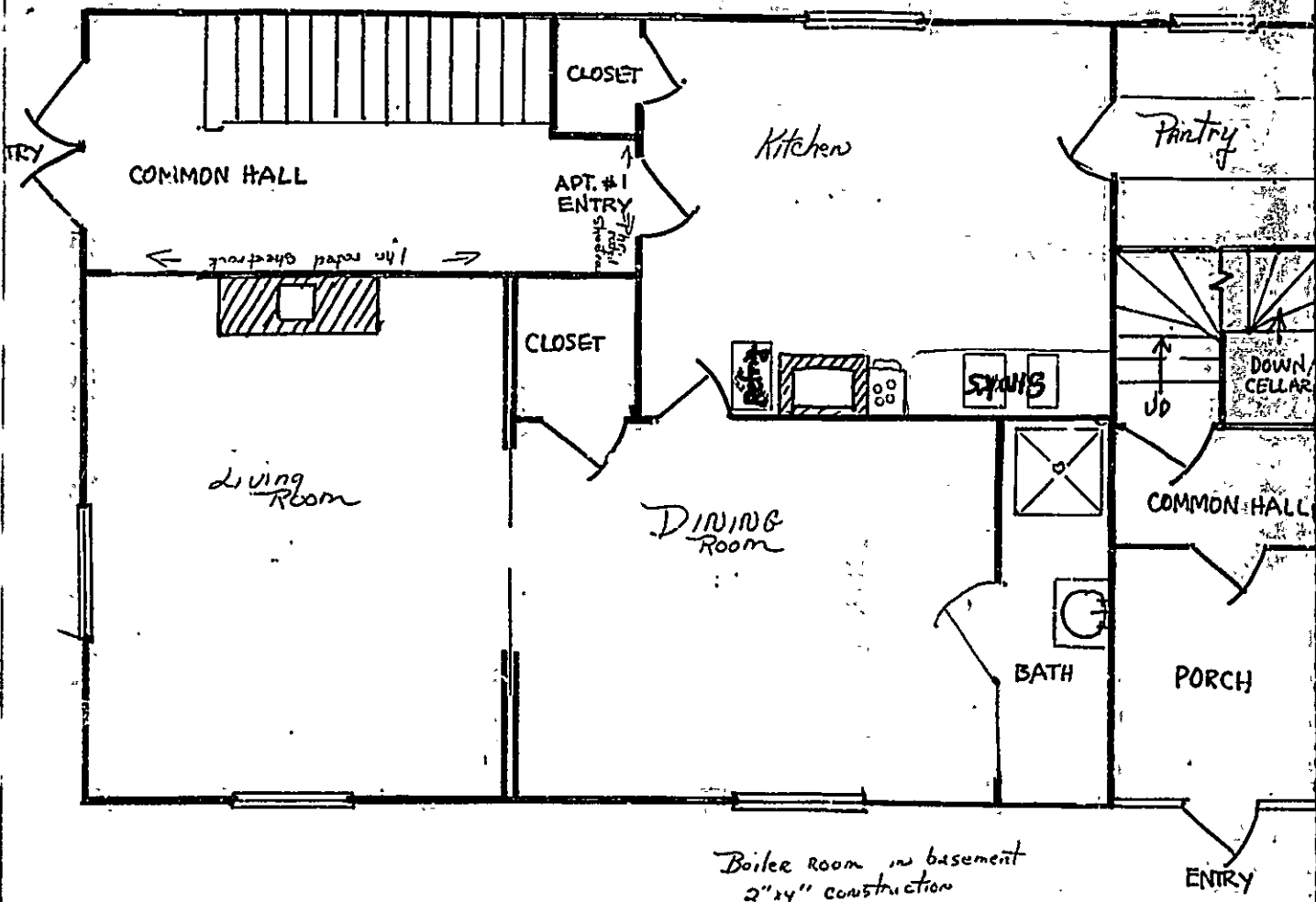

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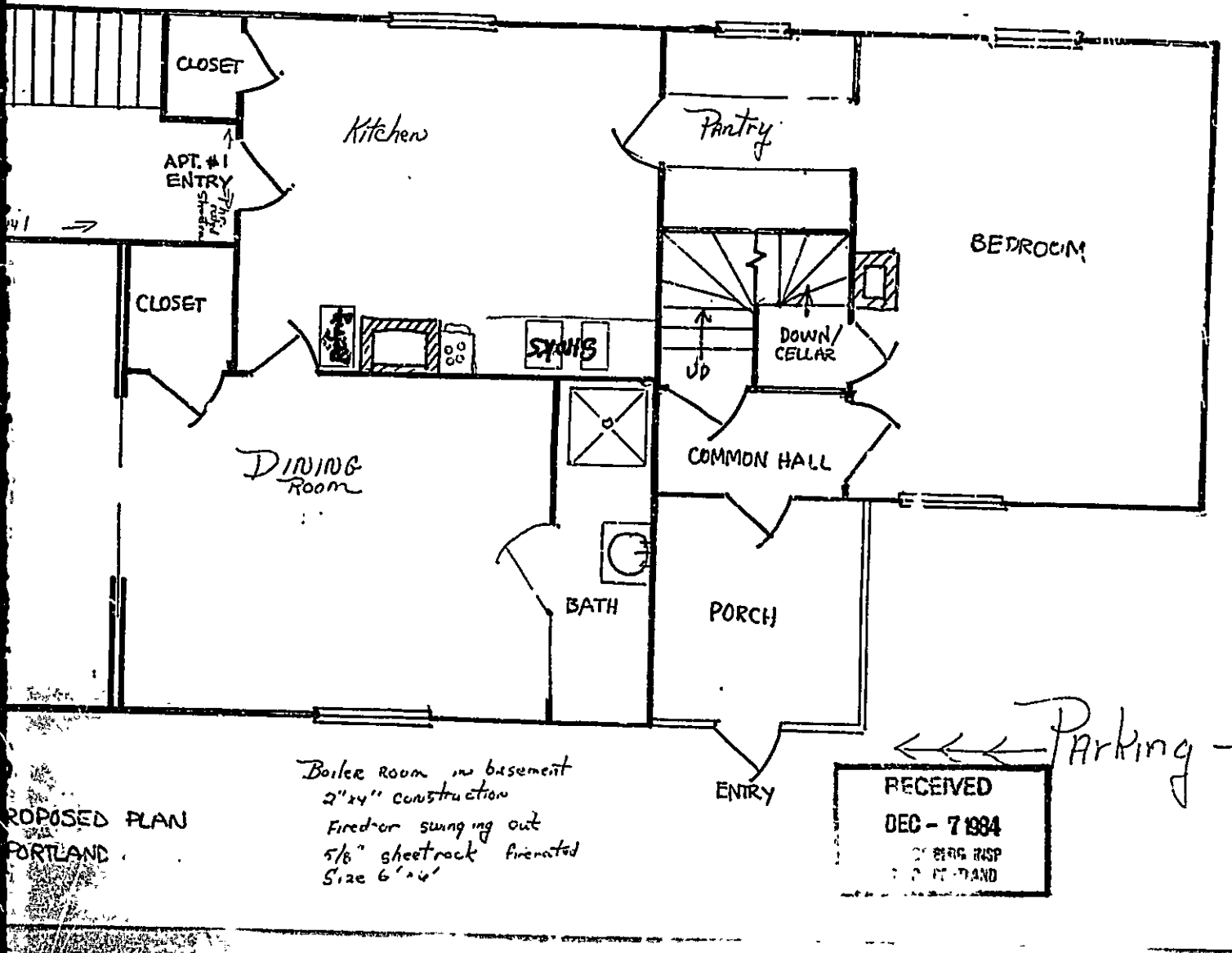

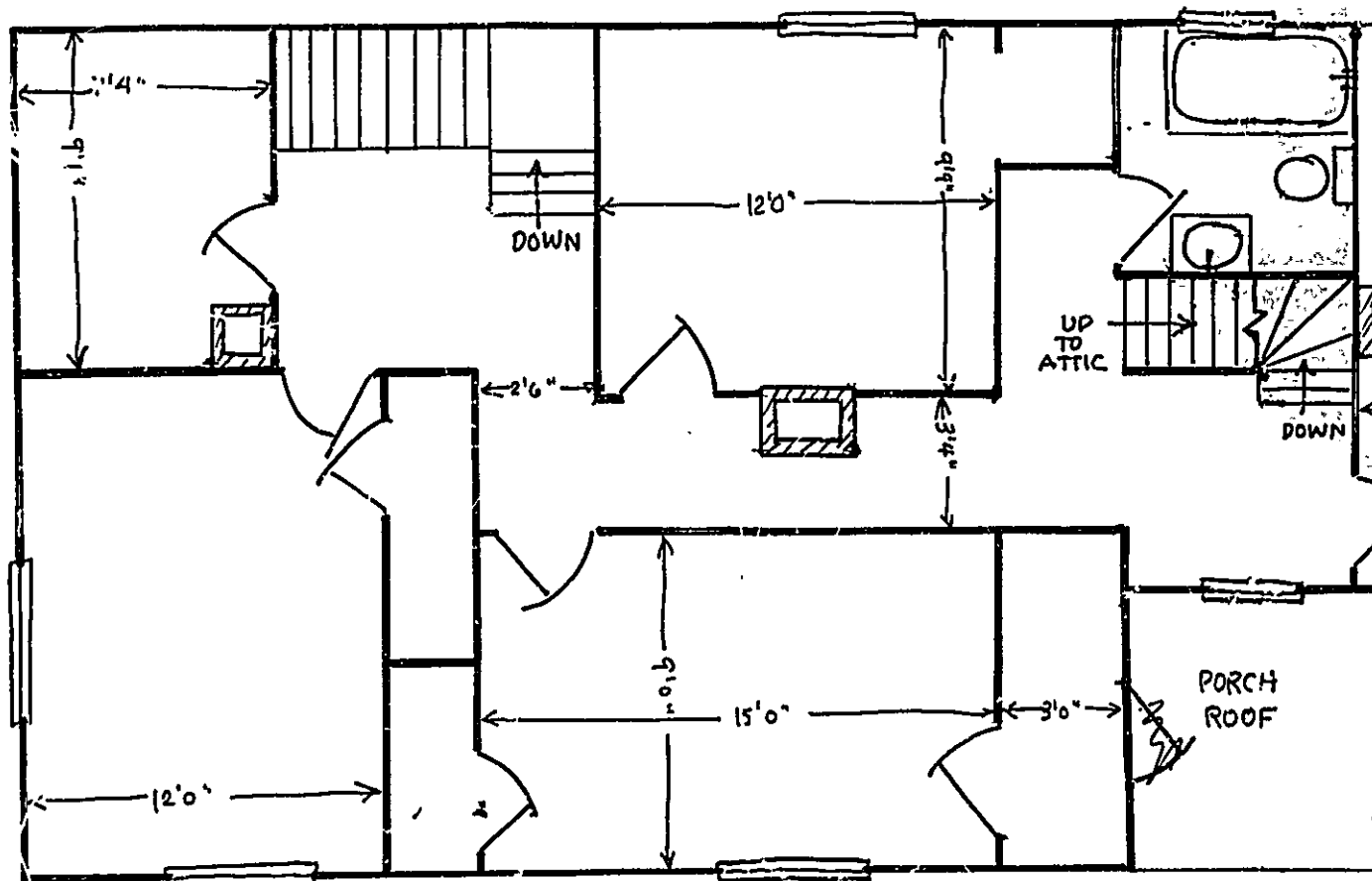
FIRST FLOOR PROPOSED PLAN.

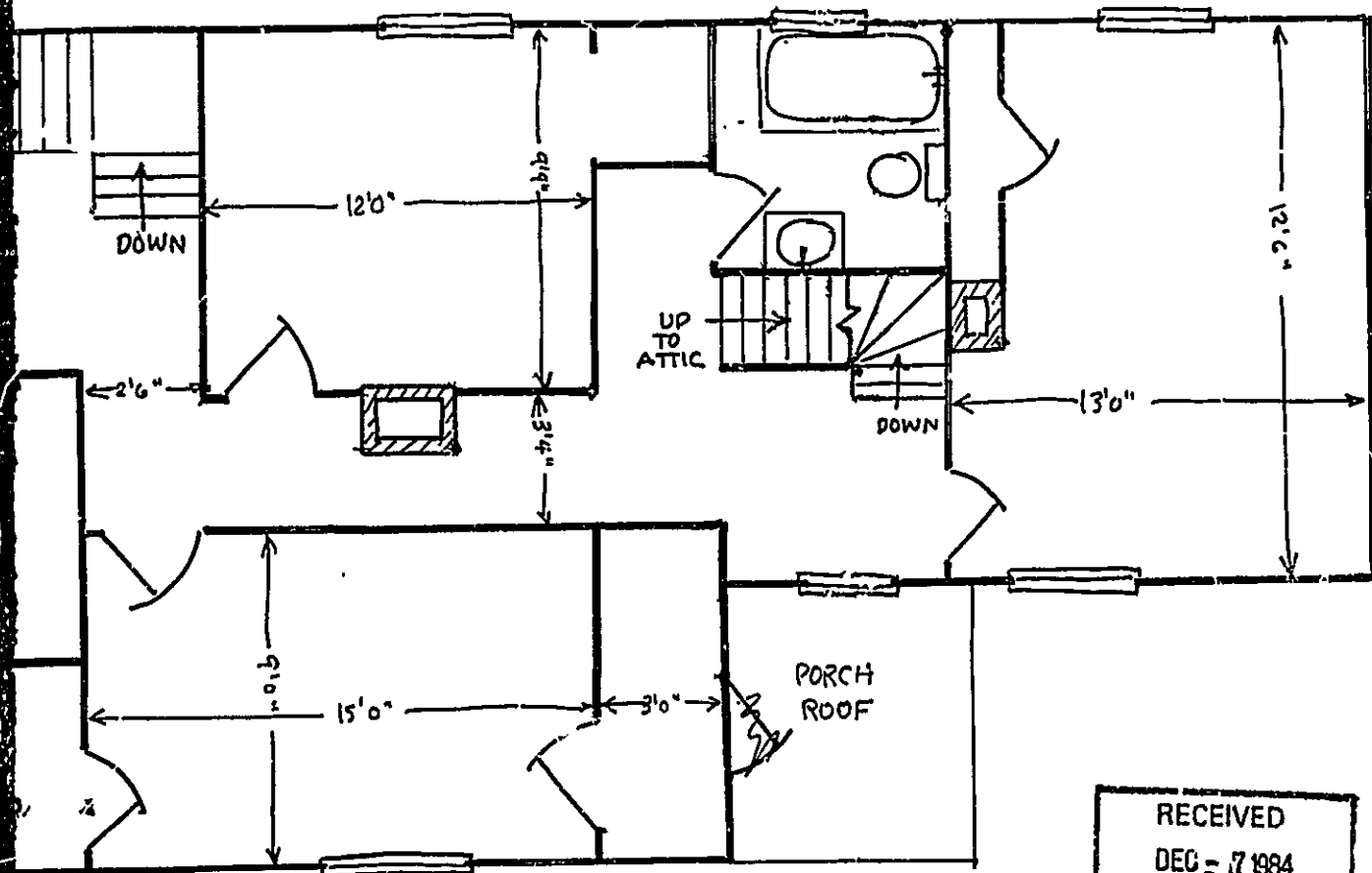

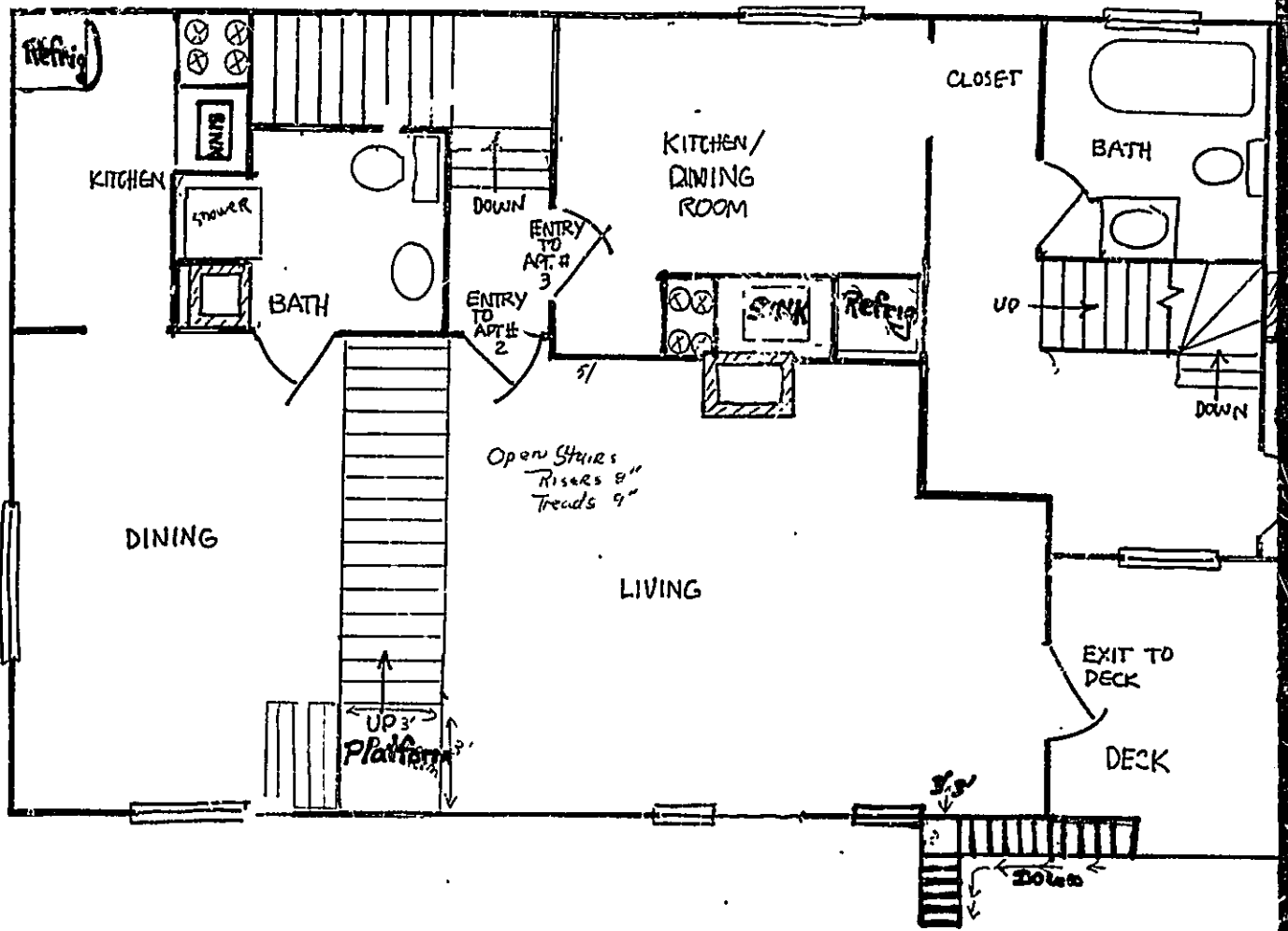


SECOND FLOOR EXISTING PLAN

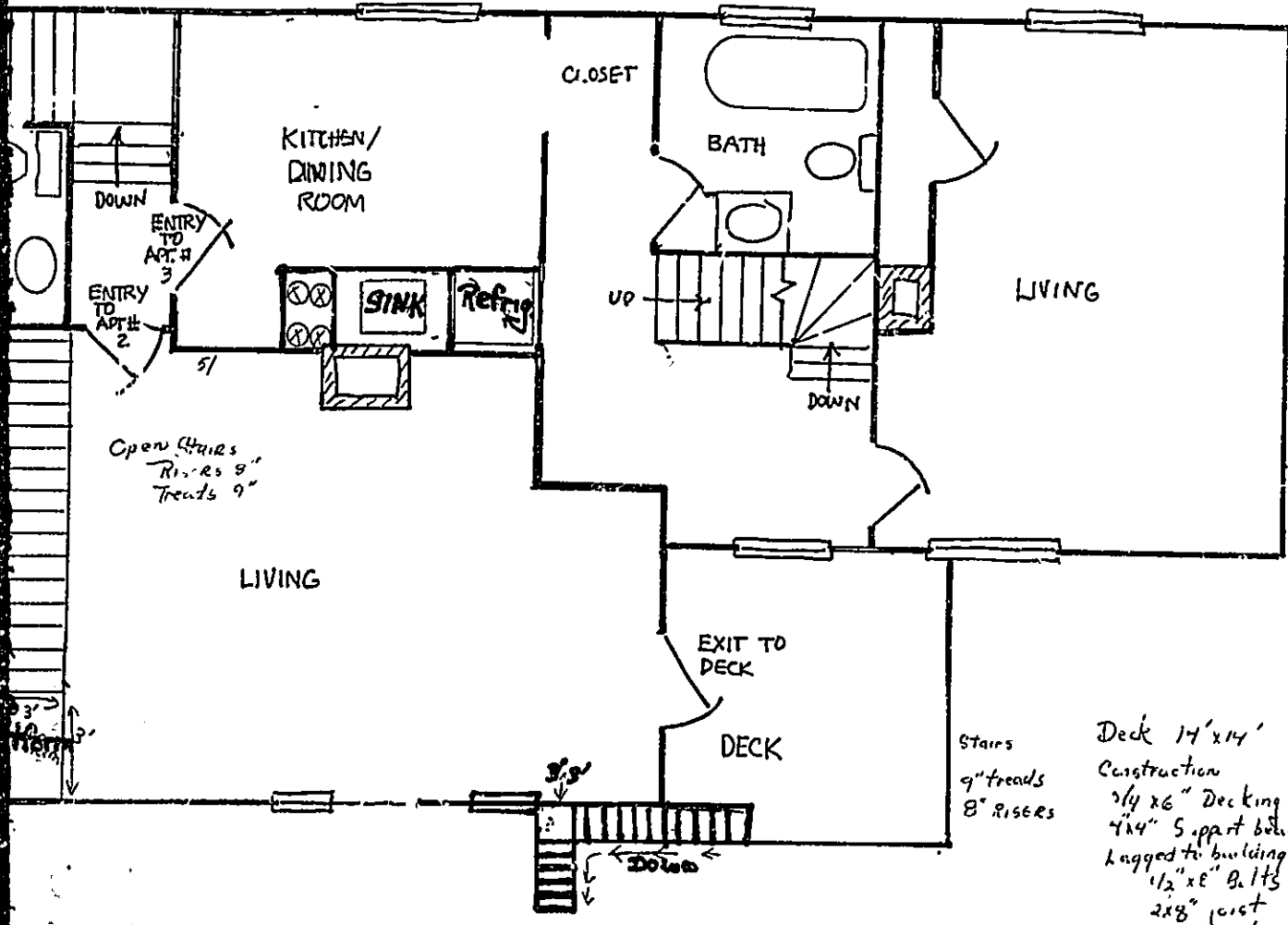

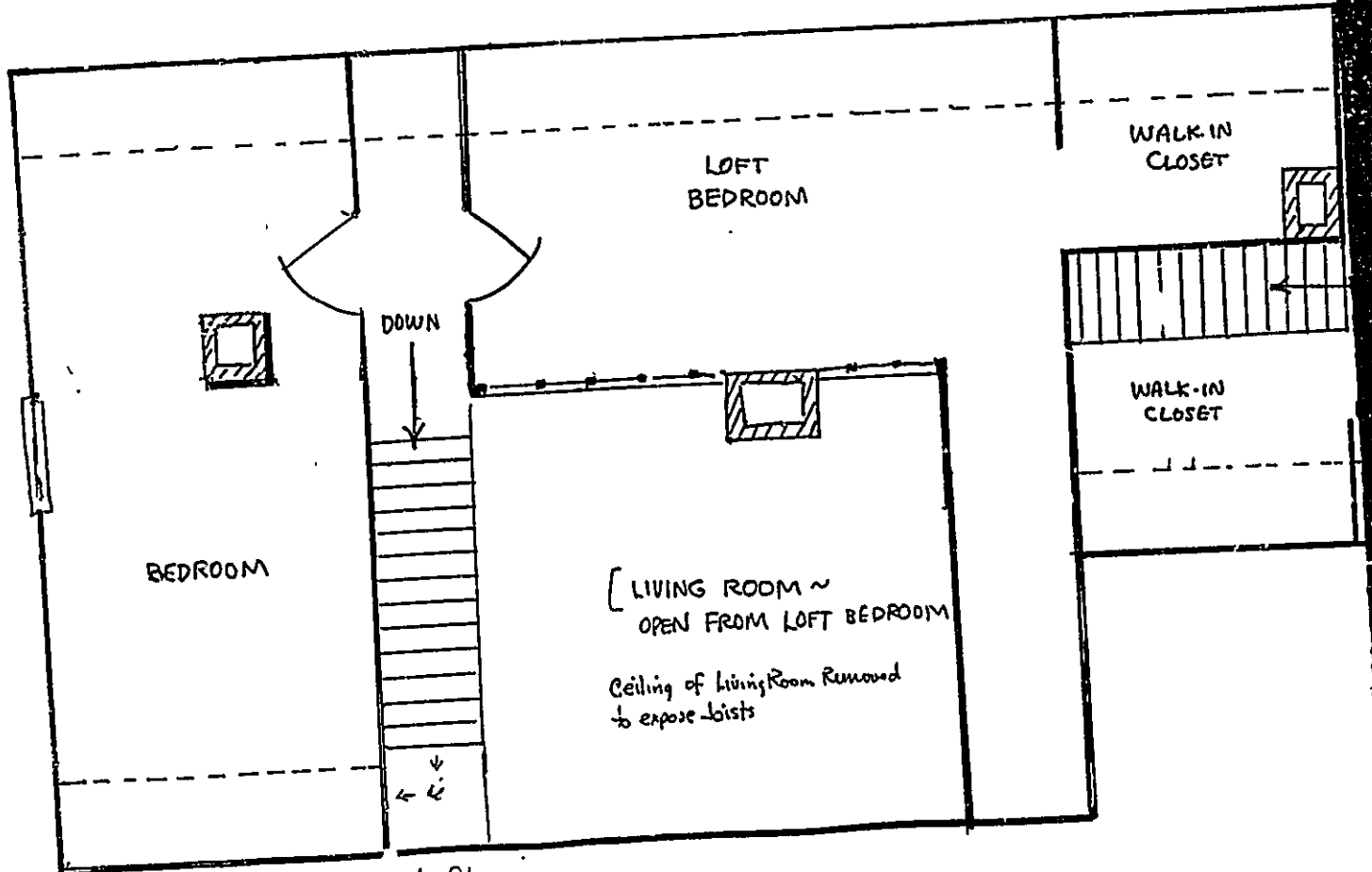
SECOND FLOOR PROPOSED PLAN



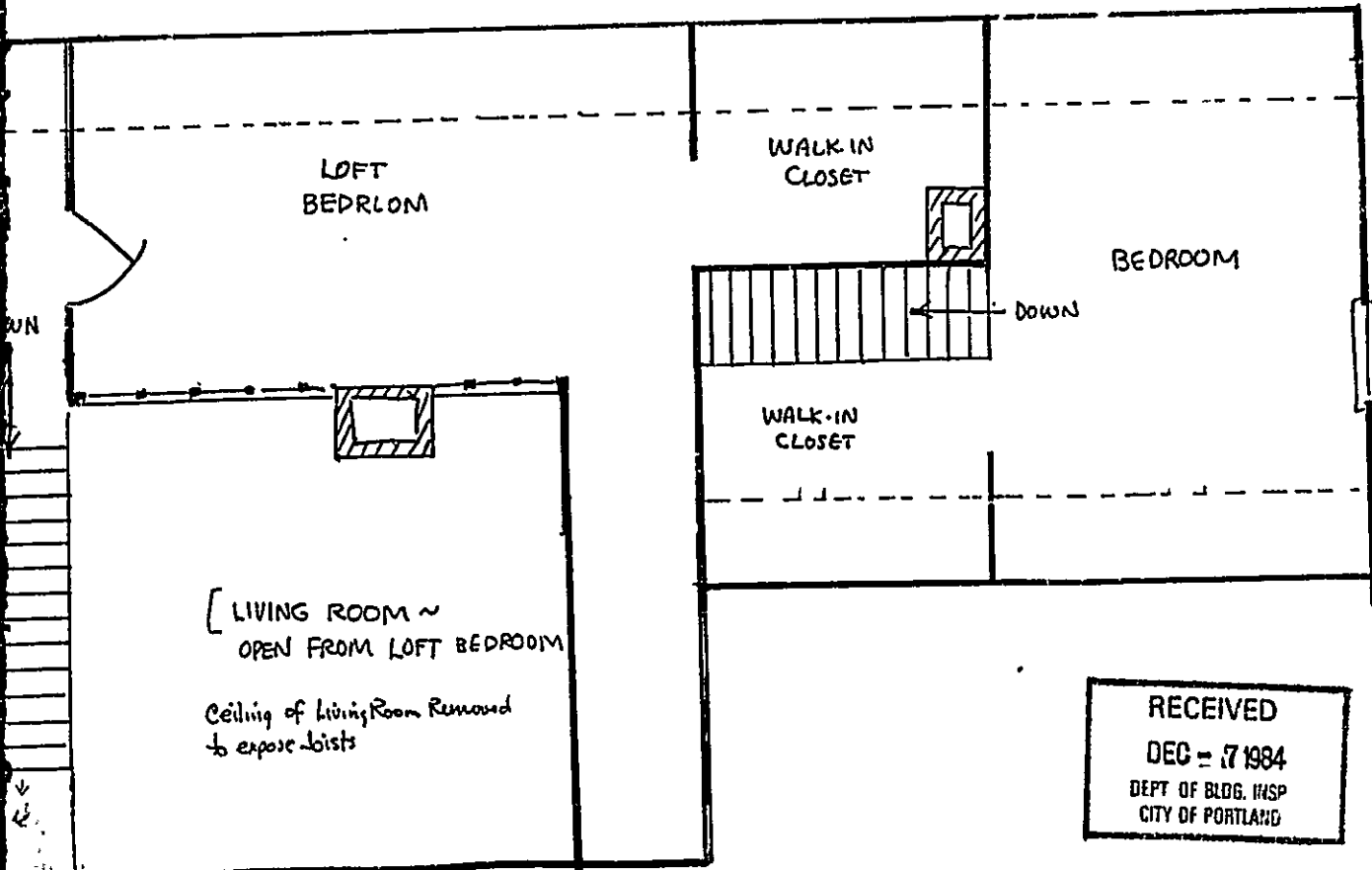

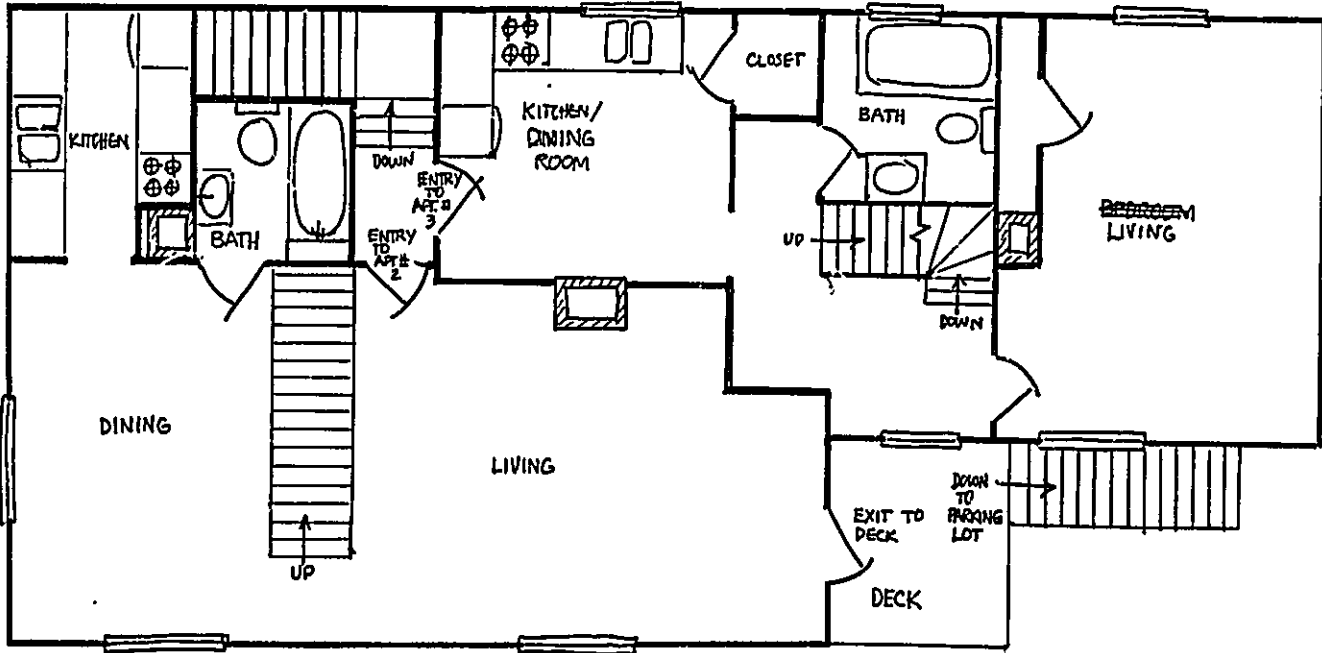
FLOOR PLAN

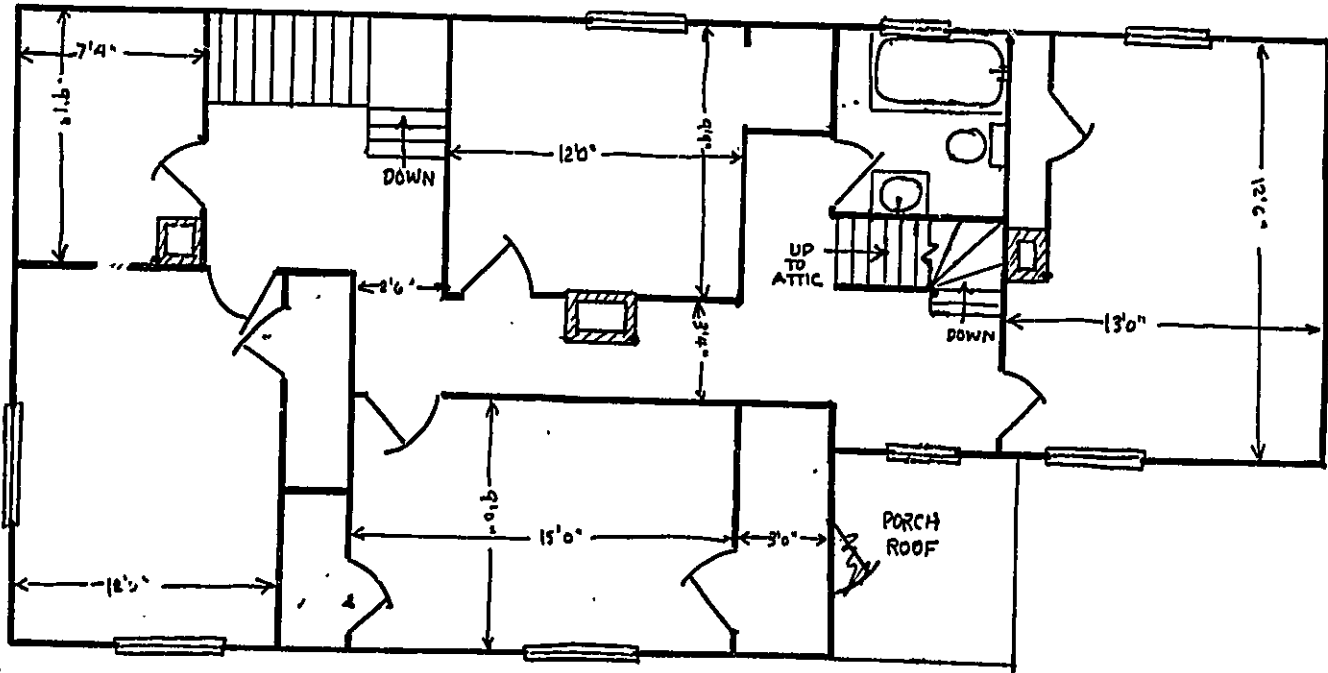

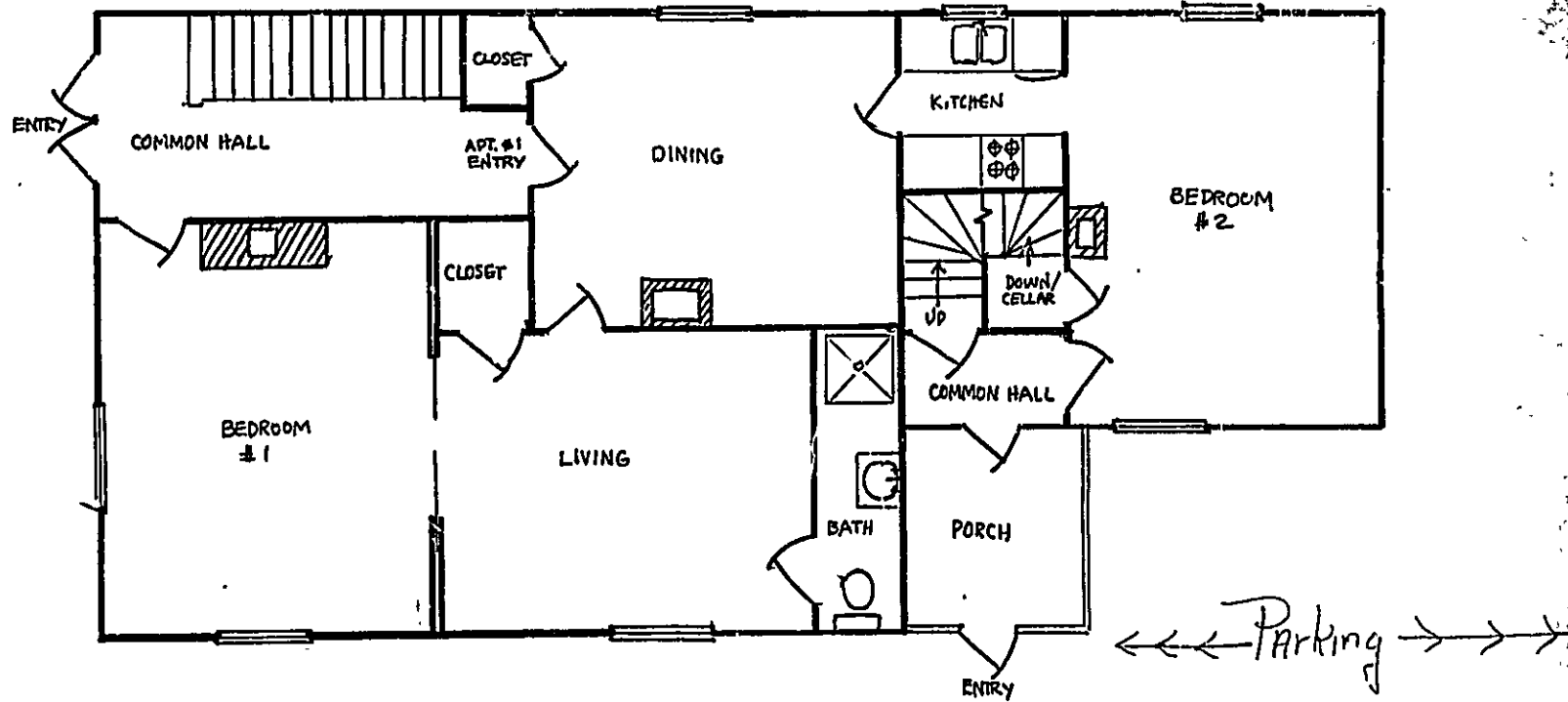

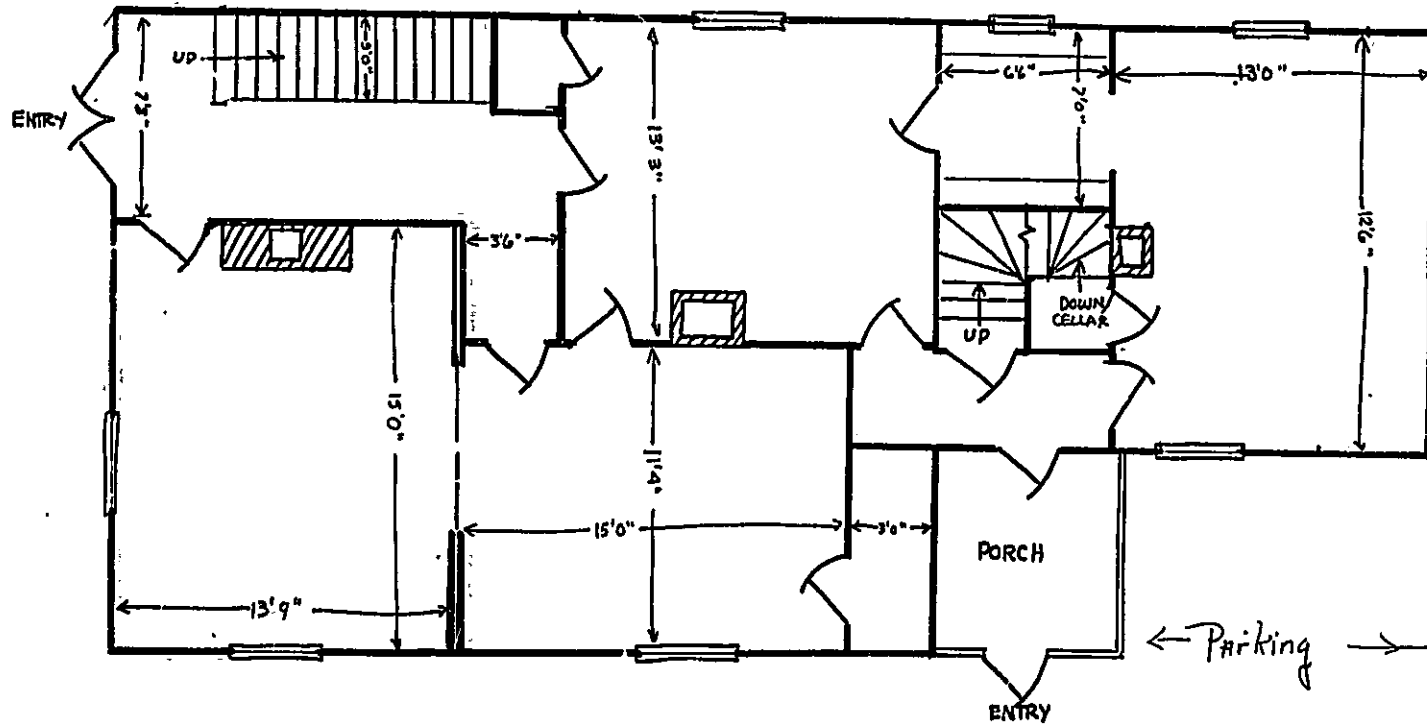
SECOND FLOOR EXISTING PLAN

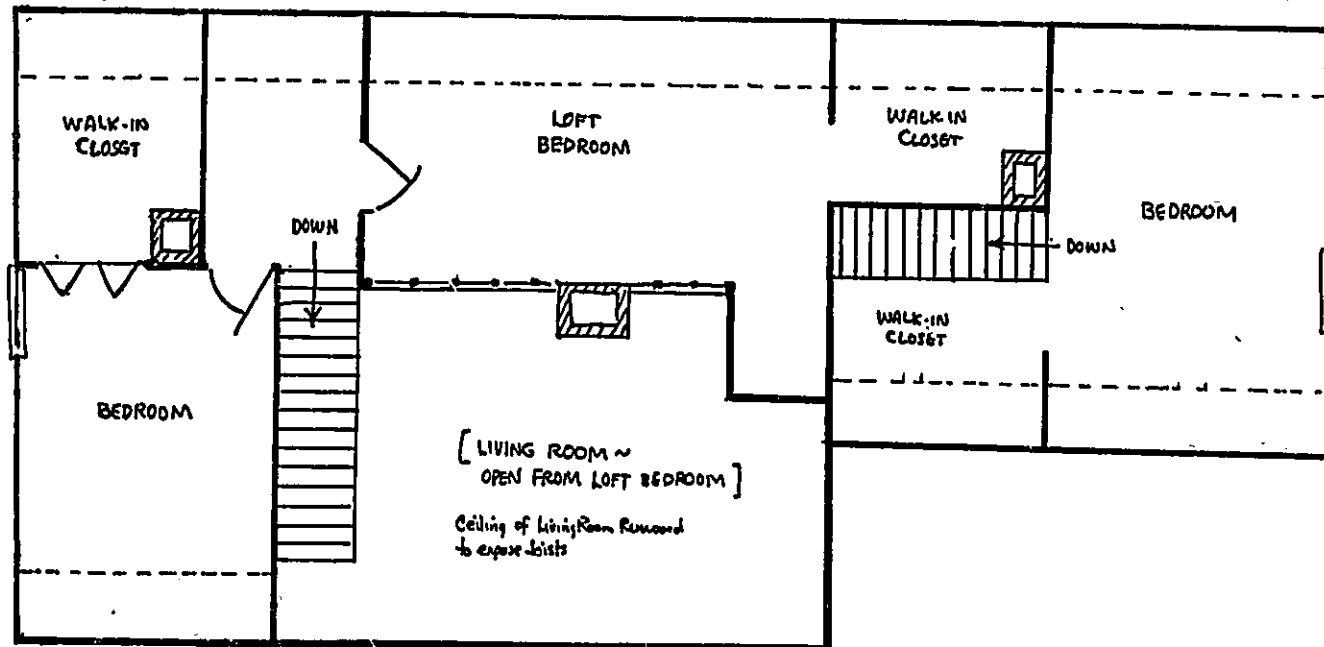
FIRST FLOOR PROPOSED PLAN
