Gentlemen:

We note that in connection with the new oil burner which you have installed for Judge Robert W. DeWolfe at 201 Danforth Street, you have seen fit to install the draft control damper in the masonry of the chimney instead of in the smokepipe of the boiler where it is usually placed.

Your Mr. Testervalt says that it was placed in the chimney because the smokepipe is very heavy and the installation in the pipe would have taken considerable time and cost more money.

There is nothing in the Building Code which specifically forbids such an arrangement, but it is certainly desirable to keep down the openings through a chimney wall to an absolute minimum. I think it is generally considered better practice to put the draft control in the smokepipe if the situation will permit. When a situation arises where the draft control is placed in the chimney wall but could have been placed in the smokepipe, it is our practice to notify the installer and owner of the situation.
