Dear Mr. Evey:-

Your inquiry as to whether it would be permissible either to build an addition on existing 6-car metal frame garage at the above location or to demolish it and rebuild it larger in size has been received.

Investigation discloses that this building does not conform with present Building Code requirements in that it is located too close to lot lines and is not equipped with the automatic sprinkler system which is required in a building used as a major garage built of metal frame construction. While the building is allowed to remain as is, we have no authority to issue a permit for any work involving an increase in size unless the entire building is to be made to comply with present Building Code requirements.

Since the building was erected about 30 years ago, it appears likely that it may be in rather poor condition and that many of its structural members may be substandard as far as present day requirements are concerned so that little of a salvageable nature would be available for construction of a new building if it were to be demolished.
