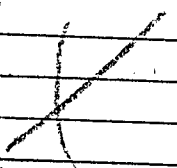

Dear Mr. Butland:

In conversation with Mrs. Shurtle concerning construction of a wood platform on which to set a "Pavilla" in the rear yard of her dwelling at 6 Bowdoin Street, she asked if a permit can be issued for such a structure if it is detached from the dwelling. It is likely that this can be done if all parts of the platform are kept at least 5 feet from the dwelling and from the side lot line and not less than 3 feet from the rear lot line, which is the inside edge of the sidewalk of Clifford Street.

If she wishes to proceed on this basis, you should furnish a plot plan showing the proposed location on the lot complying with the above requirements and change the permit application accordingly.

P.S. The required distance between any new construction and the rear lot line is 25 feet in the R-4 Residence Zone in which the property is located. Since no plot plan has been filed with application for permit, we are unable to tell just what distance the proposed platform would be from that line, but from what information we have available, it appears that the existing building is already as close or closer than 25 feet to that line.
