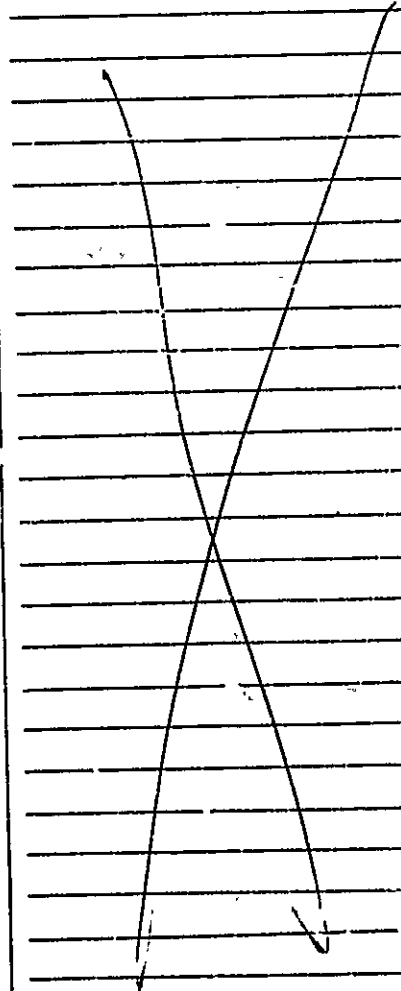

Gentlemen:

Building permit for framing cut an opening in second floor and installing a hoisting or lift arrangement to approximate an invalid elevator at 5 Clifford Street is issued to the contractor, herewith, subject to the following:

Mr. Clark, who filed the application for the permit was not advised as to the framing around the new opening in second floor nor as to the beams, posts etc. to support the hoist.

Mr. McLellan has supplemented the original information to the effect that the capacity of the hoist is 1,000 pounds, that the hoist is to be supported upon two 4" I-beams, evidently intend to spread the load over the joists of the third floor, he was not sure whether these are 2x8's or 2x10's and did not show on his sketch the spans which the joists would be on between what evidently are bearing partitions made up of 2x4 studs.

While we have full confidence in Mr. McLellan to put this up in substantial manner, the Code directs that we shall have more definite information than has been thus far shown. Nevertheless we are issuing the permit on the basis that the spans of the third floor joists will not be excessive and that the bearing partitions shown beneath these joists have the loads which they will carry safely distributed down through to the ground beneath the building through girders, columns or otherwise.

Enclosing partitions around the shaftway are required to be framed with no less than 2x3 studs, no more than 16" from center to center and contractor should see to it that notice to this office is given and inspection secured before the partitions are covered from view on either side.
