## Memorandum from Department of Building Inspection, Portland, Maine

120 West Street--Installation of small passenger elevator for W. W. Thomas by the Portland Company--5/7/46

To Owner & Installer:

In the absence of an plan, it is not possible to check the supports or space of the overhead beams. The loads are small, but I presume the installer has checked thoroughly the reaction of the overhead beams down through the building so that none of the frame or supports will be overloaded clear down to the ground, and that the installer is bearing in mind that a factor of safety of six is required in all materials.

A small discrepancy appears in that the Building Code requires that all passenger elevators have a lifting capacity of at least 75 pounds per square foot of platform. This platform having 9 square feet and 500 pounds capacity does not meet that figure, but we shall not object under the circumstances if the owner adheres to the limitations.
