To the Inspector of Buildings of the City of Portland:

The undersigned respectfully makes application for a permit to erect ~~enlarge~~ a building on Chadwick street, at number 18-224 to be two stories high by line and on half feet long, Forty-two feet wide; also an addition to be \_\_\_\_\_ stories high, \_\_\_\_\_ feet long, \_\_\_\_\_ feet wide, and to be used as a \_\_\_\_\_

CELLAR WALL - To be constructed of stone to be 20 inches wide on bottom and batter to 8 inches on top

UNDERPINNING - To be concrete. Height of underpinning from top of cellar wall to bottom of sill about 2 ft. 10 inches to be 13 inches in thickness.

EXTERIOR WALLS - To be constructed of brick. If of Brick, Stone, etc. Total Height of wall about 16 ft. 0 inches. Thickness of 1st 12" 12" th story walls. If of reinforced concrete, state mix and reinforcing system to be used.

This building will be used for the purposes of Garage and Stable (If for apartments, tenements, or other family uses state number of families accommodated and number on each floor. If for manufacturing or mercantile purposes state character of business and amount of estimated weight to be carried by the floor.)

If building is used for tenement house or family use and more than one family, the following provisions of the Building Laws regarding dividing partitions shall be adhered to (Quote Law re. this.)

FIRESTOPS - All bearing and center partitions will have firestops cut in tight on top of each partition cap and between each set of floor timbers. Where ledger board are used there shall be firestops cut in tight against bottom of ledger board, of same size as wall studs. Also wherever the Inspector of Buildings may consider necessary.

STAIRWAYS - No in building. One location in hallway to be enclosed with brick walls to be lathed with \_\_\_\_\_ lathing.

ROOF - To be constructed of rafters. Rafters to be 2 x 8 inches to be spaced about 20 inches on centers. Roof to be covered with slate

Gutters to be made of shut metal. Cornices to be made of wood

Bay Windows to be made of iron to be covered with \_\_\_\_\_

Dormer Windows to be made of shut metal to be covered \_\_\_\_\_

Chimneys, Smoke Flues to be lined with tile and provided with a 10-inch outside collar and an inside collar to go to the inside of the flue.

Estimated Cost of Building: 5000

INSPECTION - The Inspector of Buildings is to be notified when building is ready for lathing and at least 24 hours before the lathing is begun.
