1005 Congress Street—enclosing existing fuel oil tank for Evelyn Paul by
Paul Hanna, contractor—9/12/51

Permit for the above work is issued subject to the following. If
you are unable or unwilling to abide by the conditions, it is important
that you refrain from starting the work and return the permit card immediately
for adjustment:

The concrete blocks used in the side and end walls of the enclosure
are to have the open spaces or voids in them completely filled with concrete
as the walls are built from the bottom up, not waiting until the walls are
all built and depending upon the concrete working its way down through the
center of the wall.

The side and end walls of the enclosure are to extend no less than
12" above the highest part of the tank and the blocks above the level of
the tank are to be filled with concrete as well as those below that level.

The fill of sand or well tamped earth is to be carried up to a
level not more than 2" below the top of the surrounding walls of the en-
closure.

Dear Mrs. Walsh:

You were given the correct answer at this office with regard to a proposal to enter by way of preparing sandwiches for parties etc. in your apartment on the third floor of the 3-family house at 1007 Congress Street. You were also advised to get in touch with the Health Department as to the requirements for handling food to be sold.

One thing more occurs to me that I think you ought to know about. Presumably at present you mean to do business in a small way, perhaps in your own kitchen, without additional equipment by way of extra cooking devices or anything of the kind. If this venture is successful, it would be natural for you to want to expand where you are. At some point the proposal would cease to be accessory to the apartment and would become a definite business with perhaps some increased fire hazard. In such a case a permit would be required from this department to convert any part or all of the apartment to the business use. At that time it would be necessary to apply for a building permit for change of use at this department. Information furnished so that it could be determined what application the Building Code had to the proposition. It is certain that there would be some difficulties because the Building Code provides for special protection around all stairways and special protection around the heater when a building for business purposes is more than two stories in height.
