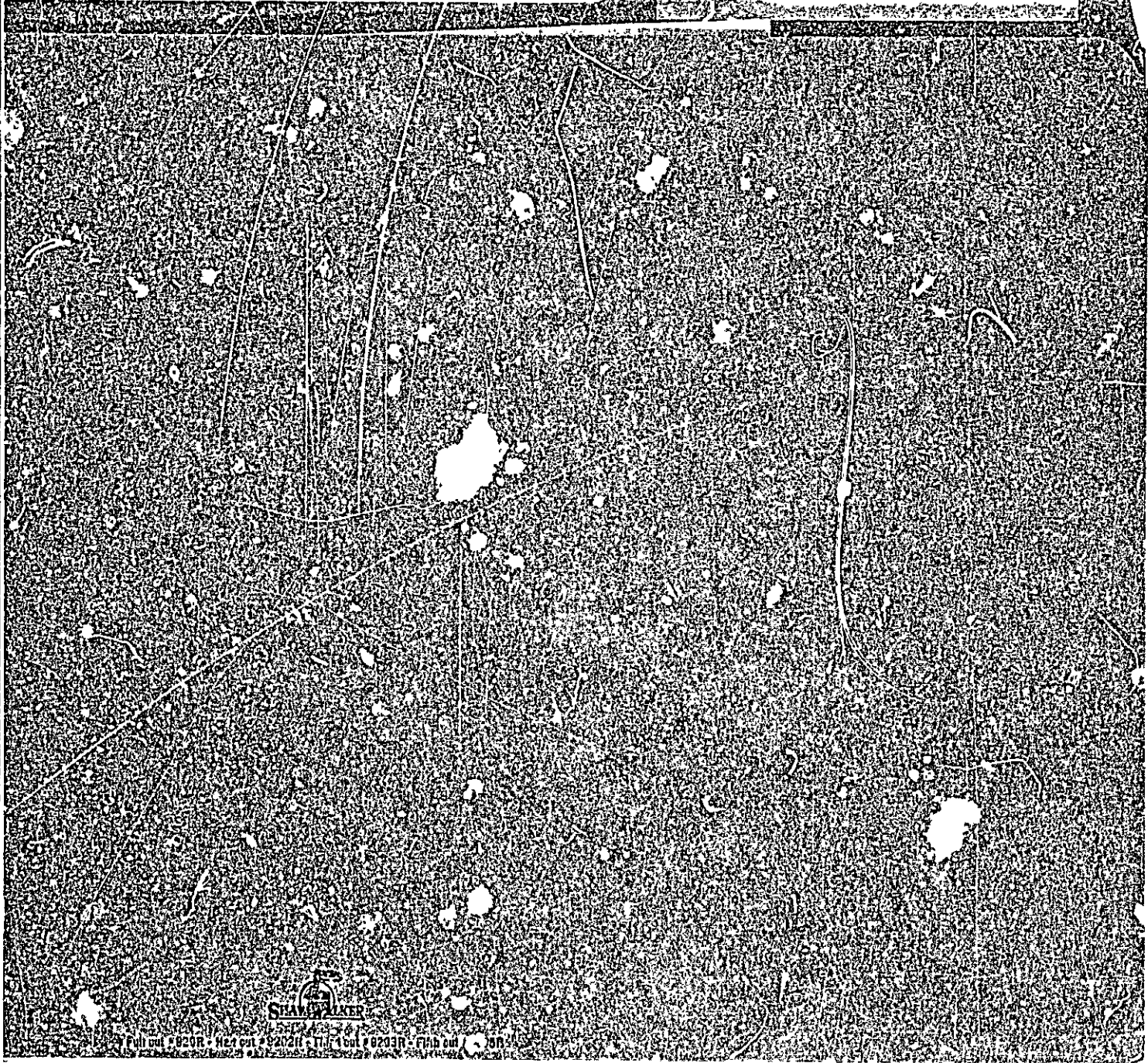

I recognize that there are a great many demolitions going on in the City as you well know, a good portion of which you are performing. However, quite frankly I am getting rather tired and sick of seeing them come over my desk dated on one day and hopefully being sent out on the next and the Health Department has to say, unable to conduct an inspection because the building was already started to be demolished.

I am aware of the need to demolish certain buildings within the City, but you must give us time to do our work. We try to get it out for you as fast as it comes through this office. In the future I would suggest that you wait until you get the permit before you go ahead and demolish the building, or else one of these days you and I are going to have to meet each other over in the Court House and I hope that can be avoided. I shall not hesitate to take that step in the future because I have asked you many many times before about demolishing before a permit is issued and that is a violation of the ordinances of the City of Portland. Please be guided accordingly.

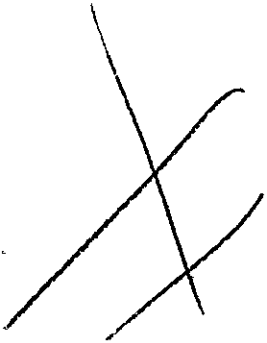
