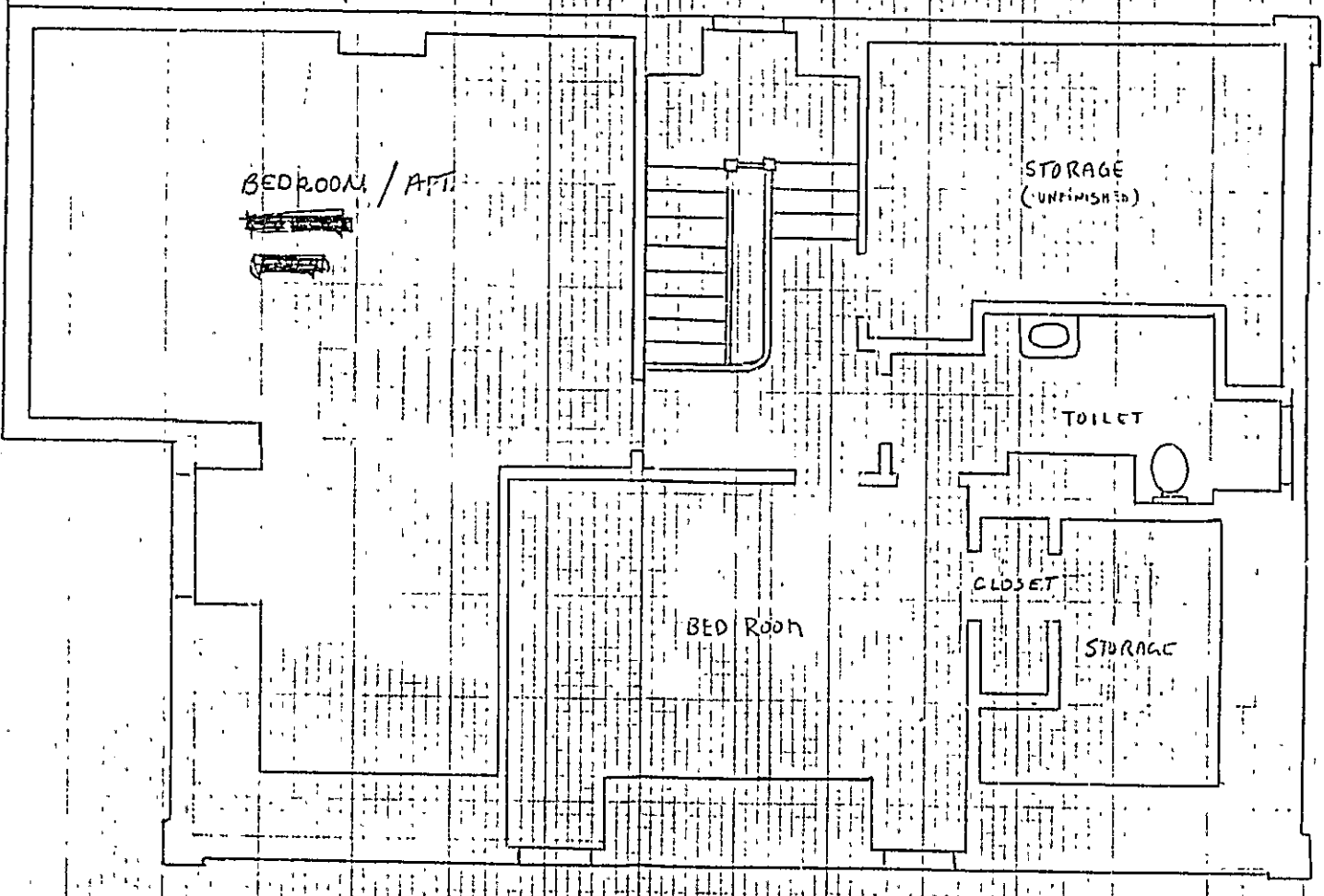


COIT RESIDENCE
