
Dear Mr. Comeau:

A recent inspection at the above named address of which you are listed the present owner, showed that alterations have been completed, or are in the process of being completed, that require building permits from the City of Portland as defined in the 1981 BOCA Building Code and/or Portland Municipal Code 111:1,4.

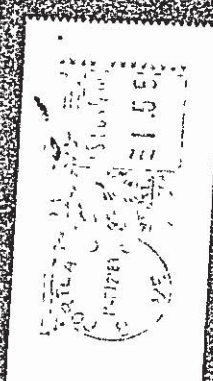

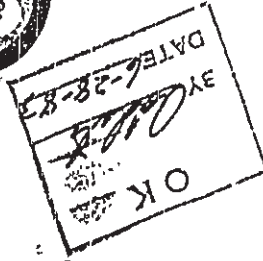

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
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
