Dear Howard:

I have referred this soils analysis of the subject lot to the City Plumbing Inspector for review and he has indicated that it is o.k. for a buildable lot, but at the time an application for a building permit is applied for, the applicant must submit three (3) copies of the Form HHE-200 Soil Test results by an approved soil analyst.

The existing Form is adequate provided the building permit application is planned within a short period of time. The existing form reporting soil test results are valid until such time as the state amends its requirements. This has not been done recently.
