Gentlemen:-

Upon inspection of the above job on January 22, 1953, our inspector reports the following criticisms or defects:

The vent for this oil tank does not have the usual protective cap, a tin can having been placed over the outlet. Besides not providing proper venting, especially if the can should be flat against the opening, the storage tank would be open to foreign substances, including dirt and dust, should the can be removed accidentally or otherwise. This could prove both dangerous and costly to the owner.

No instruction card was in evidence. Please see that one is provided and posted near the furnace for the convenience and reference of the owner.

There is an unused opening in the back side of the chimney with a temporary plug. This plug is to be removed and the opening permanently closed by being bricked up.

It is important that correction of these conditions be made before February 20, 1953, and notify this office of readiness for another inspection.

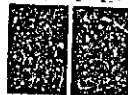
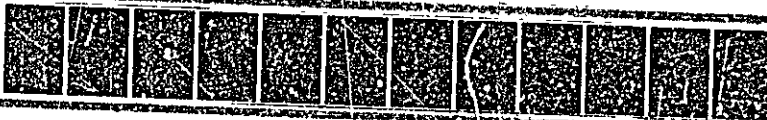
