Dear Sir:

I shall have to know considerably more about the above job before a permit may be issued. If this is a normal fireplace flue which you intend to use in the cellar, it is not allowable merely to cut a hole in the floor of the fireplace, brick up the opening in the room and use the chimney in that condition.

It will rather be necessary to extend the fireplace flue in the usual manner making a tight job around the place where the throat of the fireplace takes off from this throat down to the bottom of the cellar floor, all of the new section to be lined and a cast iron cleanout door to be put in leading to the new flue.

We shall not insist on removing the fireplace and it is all right to brick up the opening but there can be no connection between the new extended chimney flue and the rest of the space which is now a fireplace or with the space which may be now a dump for ashes beneath the fireplace.

What I am trying to say is that when you get all through you must have an integral chimney flue of uniform cross sectional dimensions clear from the top of the chimney to the cellar floor.

I suggest that you go over this matter in detail with Mr. Keening (who is receiving a copy of this letter) and decide how to do the job. Then change the application perhaps supplying a plan which means something to us as to just how it is to be done.

Perhaps your first reaction will be to come here and talk about it, and I wish very much that we were able to sit down and talk over all of these problems with property owners. Unfortunately this office has become such a busy place with so much work continually on hand that there is no time whatever for detailed conferences about these matters. Please try and avoid them.
