Dear Judge Pinesky:

Referring to a violation of the Building Code which we have at the cottage of Mrs. Charlotte Glasier on Sunset road, Peaks Island, and your telephone call to this office about it, will you be kind enough to give us some definite date upon which your client can make good this violation.

We have had considerable difficulty on the Island through the years to make it clear that Building Code regulations apply to property on the Island as well as on the main land.

Unfortunately the attention of some of the islanders has been focused upon this violation, and whether or not Mr. Glasier knew the requirements does not change the situation materially. I do not know how much patching he has done upon the roof but it may be that he can remove the new wooden shingles and insert metal or asbestos, as distinguished from asphalt shingles, in their places. Even this work requires a permit from this department before it is done.

It seems reasonable to insist that Mr. Glasier have this deficiency made good at least by September 2, 1933, before Labor Day ends the summer season.

Dear Madam:

It appears that the roof of the cottage which you are reported to own on Samsot Road, Fisks Island within the limits of this city has been pitched using wooden shingles.

Such work is in violation of the Building Code of the city in two particulars,--first because no permit from this department was first secured as required by law; and second the building law forbids the use of wooden shingles on such a roof.

I understand that Mr. Glazier was in charge of this work, perhaps did some of it himself. In either case he is liable under the building law, and I must require that you have this matter adjusted so as to eliminate the exposed wooden shingles that have been recently put on the roof, securing a permit first from this department for roof repairs and stating just how the work is to be done and with what material, at least by August 15, 1935.

Had Mr. Glazier applied for a permit, he would have been told that wooden shingles were not permissible. Asphalt shingles or asphalt rolled roofing may be used on such a roof, but each package must bear upon it the red label of the Underwriters' Laboratories, Inc. identifying the roofing material and giving the grade known as "Class D".

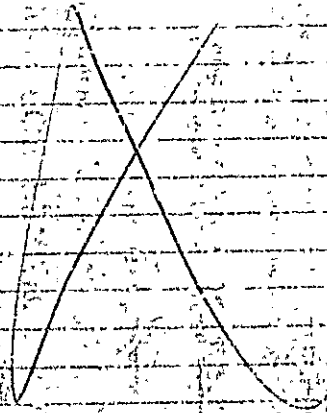
