Dear Howard:

It is my understanding that Mr. Sherman L. Pelton has divided Lot 90-J-1 into two parcels: one containing a residence which he intends to sell and a second vacant parcel which contained about just under the required 20,000 square feet of land area.

It is my understanding that Mr. Pelton subsequently acquired by purchase an abutting parcel of land containing about 3,040 square feet of land area (Lot 90-J-5) which is an 8 foot strip which he purchased from the Maine Medical Center. It is my understanding also that Mr. Christopher S. Yeagle of the firm of Verrill & Dana has been handling these legal matters for Mr. Pelton.

With the recent acquisition of additional abutting land, the remaining vacant parcel now becomes capable of being built upon subject to the approval of the soil analysis tests for the proposed new residence which will be a single family. Such soil test results are subject to approval by the City Plumbing Inspector before a building permit can be issued for a proposed building.


The remaining vacant parcel with the additional acquisition of land area from the Maine Medical Center will now meet the minimum lot size for the II-2 Island Residence 2 Zone, or in excess of 20,640 square feet of land area, subject to the approval of the soil test results by the City Plumbing Inspector.
