Dear Mr. and Mrs. Luzenko:

It appears that you have been keeping live poultry on your property since sometime last spring.

Your property is located under the Zoning Ordinance in an Apartment House Zone, where, according to Section 8A of the Ordinance applying to such zones, the keeping of poultry is not an allowable use of building or premises.

It is important that you discontinue the keeping of poultry without delay, thus placing yourselves and your property in conformity with the law.

When violation of the Zoning Ordinance is found, I am directed to notify the Corporation Counsel of the City, who is authorized to take steps to compel compliance with the law. However, as a practical matter, this department tries to clear the matter up without recourse to legal proceedings.

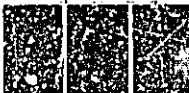
If the poultry is disposed of, as well as any shelters which may have been unlawfully erected to accommodate them, before August 1, 1955, thus clearing up the violation, no further proceedings will be necessary. Otherwise the violation will be reported to the Corporation Court for whatever steps he deems necessary.
