Dear Madam:

With reference to your letter of September 11th concerning a permit for repairing roof covering on the dwelling house of Mrs. George B. Ryan on Cliff Island, before a permit can be issued, it is necessary to fill out the regular application form furnished by this department, and to sign the same.

In the hope that it will be of some convenience to you and to Mrs. Ryan, I am sending to you two copies of the application form all filled out ready for Mrs. Ryan to sign. The fee of fifty cents (50¢) which you have furnished is correct. You will note that the application calls for a certain standard or type of roof covering which is required by law as a minimum and is known as Class "C" Underwriters' Standard. This particular kind of roof covering, whether it is roll roofing or shingles, may be identified by a red label with the words "Class C" roofing upon the label. If the roofing is legal each bundle of roofing should have upon it this red label. If the roofing which you have does not have this label, it probably is not legal and you should get in touch with this office immediately about it, as when Mrs. Ryan has signed the application, she will have agreed to put on legal roofing.

Please have her sign both copies of this application, return both copies to this office, when the permit with a copy of the application will be returned to her.
