Enclosed is the building permit covering erection of
a two-car garage upon your property at 117 Dartmouth St.

Since one side of the proposed garage is closer than
five feet to your dwelling house, it will be necessary to leave
that side without any windows whatever in it, and that side is
required by law to have fire resistive construction on the inside
of the garage wall. In your application you have elected to use
so-called "asbestos lumber". Please note that this protection
must run from floor to roof boards, that the joints are to be
filled with cement mortar, and that the minimum thickness of the
protection is required to be three-eighths of an inch. This
material is commonly stocked in Portland 3/16 inches thick. It
will be satisfactory to use two layers of this weight of the
material.

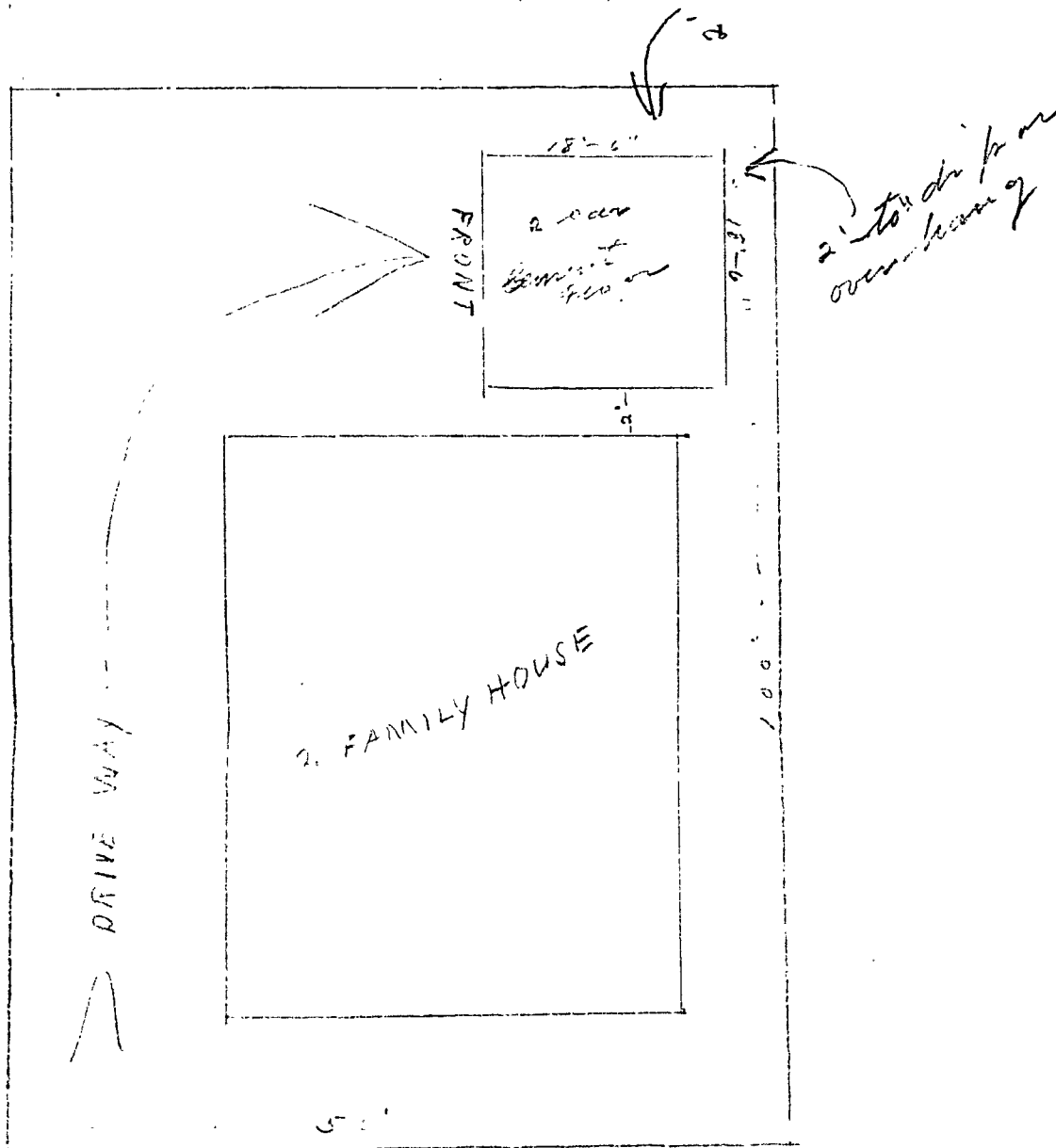
