Memorandum from Department of Building Inspection, Portland, Maine

**7 Mason Street—Reconstruction of platform and steps using wood framing
and supports for Mrs. Elsie B. Reynolds—9/1/50**

Some of the details of construction of the proposed wood platform and steps, required by the Building Code, are explained below, and the permit is issued based upon them, so that you may not go wrong and only find it out after the work is partially or all done.

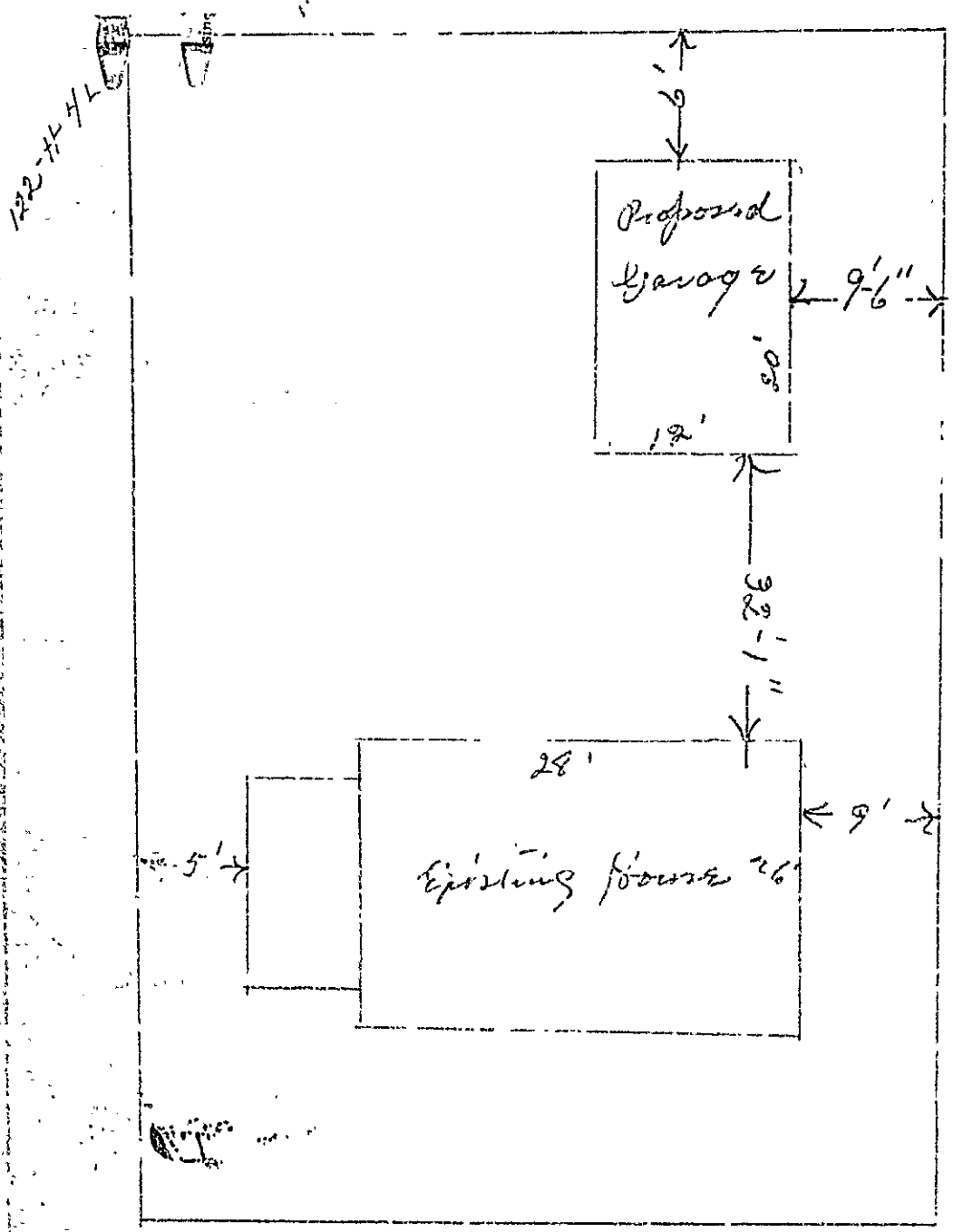
Presumably the cedar posts, extending 4' below the surface of the ground or to ledge, if ledge should be encountered at a less depth, will be used at each outside corner and also beneath the bottom of the steps. The Building Code actually requires foundations beneath such steps extending below frost, but if a home owner has an existing cement walk to rest the steps upon to keep the bottom of the steps up above the dampness of the ground, we have not insisted upon the foundations below frost at the bottom of steps in such a case.

The platform should be outlined on the three sides not against the house with 4x6 sills (solid lumber in cross section, not built up of 2x6's), using lap splices at the corners.

The floor joists, since they are to be on such a short span, could be 2x4 instead of the 2x6 indicated, if you desire, but the floor joists should either be supported on the top edge of the sills, or else supported upon not less than 2x3 nailing strips spiked to the inner side of the 4x6 sill with the bottom of the nailing strip flush with the bottom of the 4x6 sill; the latter being set with the 6" dimension upright—then the floor joists notched over the 2x3 nailing strip so that the tops of the floor joists will be flush with the top edge of the 4x6.

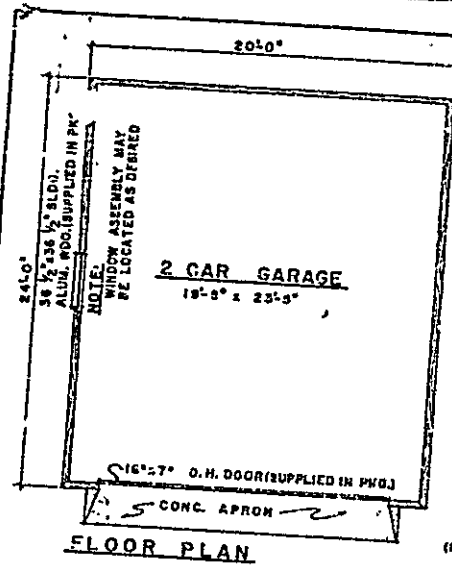

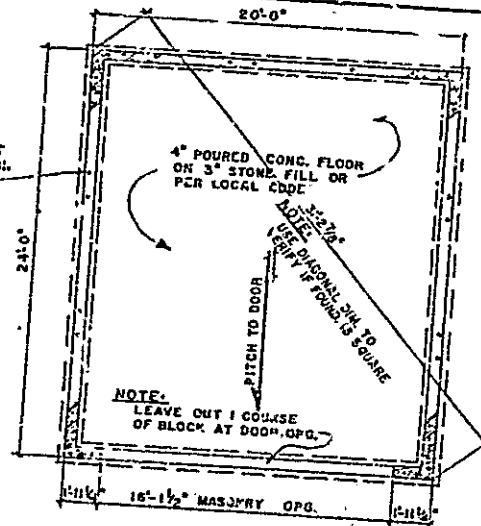

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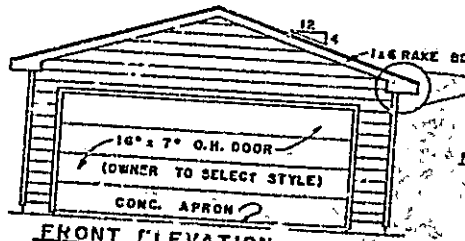


FLOOR PLAN

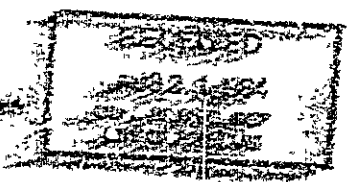
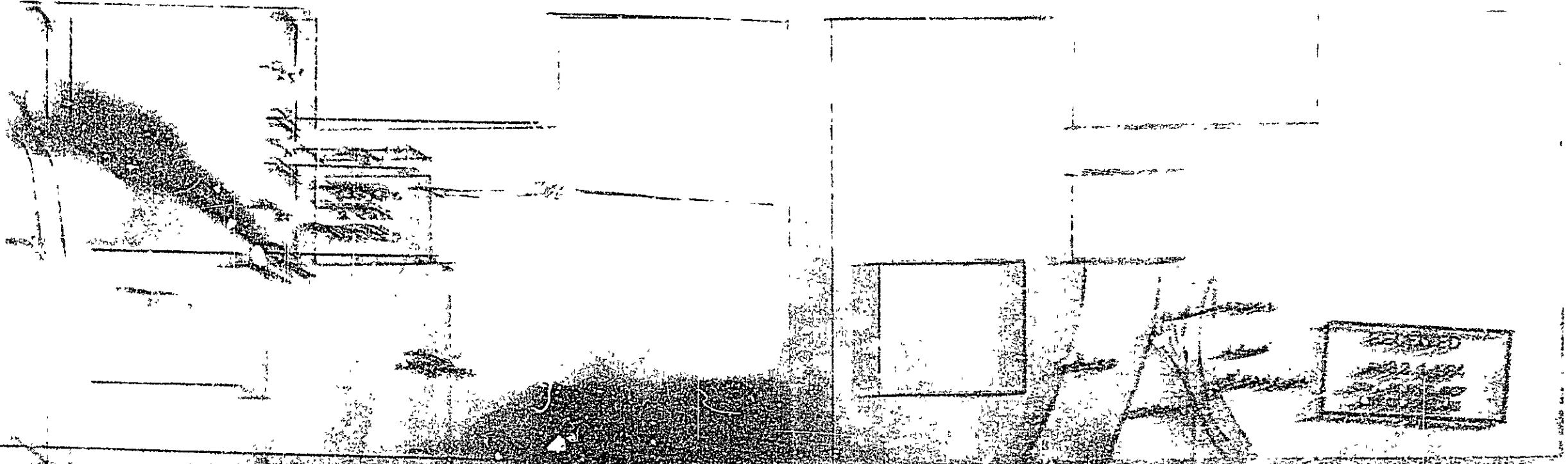
