Dear Mr. Hooper:

While our inspector reports a condition relating to the smokepipe of your heater at 185 Ashmont Street, which I believe is likely to prove hazardous at any time, I prefer to make a suggestion as regards relieving the condition rather than placing it on the basis of law and a hard and fast requirement, because this smokepipe has no doubt been in about this same situation for a long time.

He says that the ceiling over the smokepipe is covered with plaster on wooden laths and that the top of the smokepipe is only about five inches below the ceiling; also that it would be very inconvenient if the smokepipe were lower to give sufficient clearance without protection.

I suggest that you have a strip of the ceiling, including the wooden laths, removed directly over the smokepipe and about three times the diameter of the smokepipe in width; that you fit neatly into this strip a piece of gypsum wallboard cemented at the joints so that there will be no cracks up into the space above the ceiling; then provide a shield of so-called "asbestos lumber", which is rigid and supports its own weight without buckling, on wire hangers about halfway between the ceiling and the top of the smokepipe, this shield to be three times the diameter of the smokepipe in width.

This may be done, probably by yourself, at slight cost which would be a small item compared with the calamity of a fire. While you have a draft regulator in the smokepipe, and under normal conditions, the smokepipe will never get very hot, a time may come when, without your knowledge, something may happen to the draft regulator so that it will not function or soot may accumulate in the smokepipe and take fire, in which cases, without some such protection as I have suggested you are very likely to have the wooden laths and then the floor joists ignite.

A shield of asbestos is used for protection, this is nailed to some cleats to the ceiling. I spoke to Mrs Hooper and she is aware of the situation. It has always been this way and she is reconciled that it is about all that can be done.
