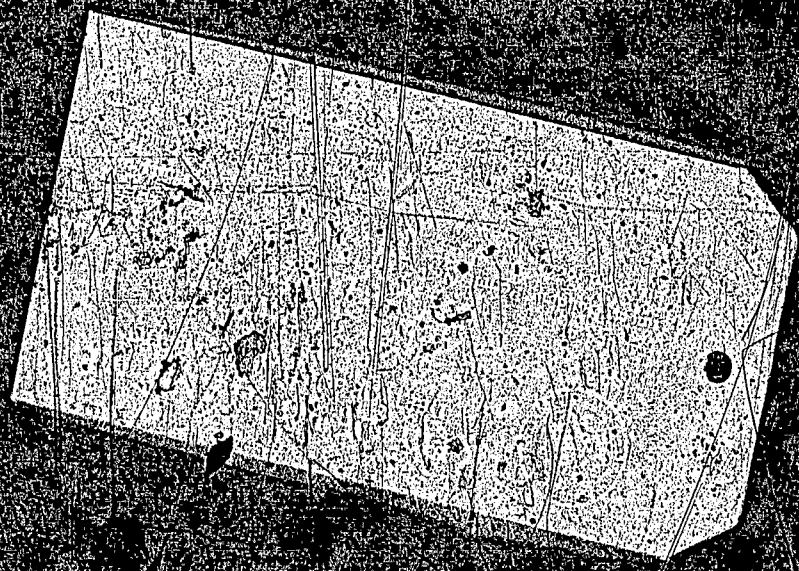

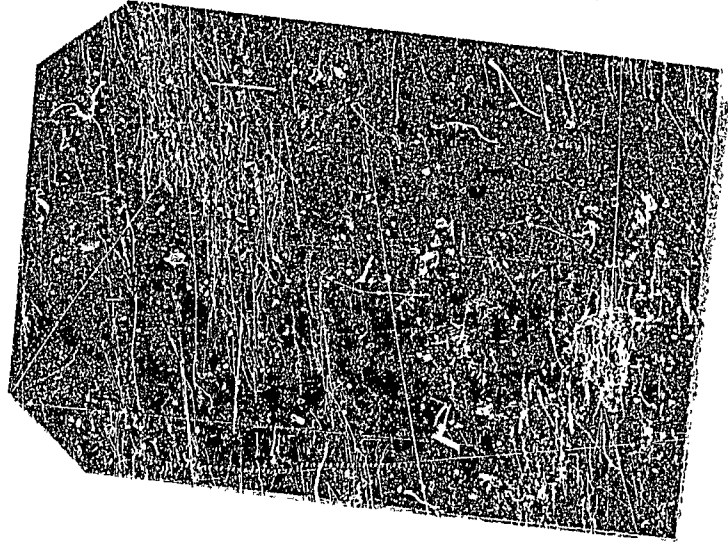

Gentlemen:

I am told that your company is the heating contractor in the new dwelling house being completed by Leslie G. Warren at 1-11 Arlington Street. We have issued a permit to cover the installation of the oil burner but none has been applied for to cover the installation of the heating system itself as required by law, although the heating system is all installed.

Perhaps you are unaware of this requirement, but if your company is the heating contractor, it will be necessary for you to make application for this belated permit, giving all the particulars in the same manner as though the system were not already installed. Such a permit for a heating appliance may only be issued to the actual installer. Even though you employed some heating man to install this system, you furnishing the material and equipment, I think it is your duty to apply for and secure the permit, the heating man that you employed can make the application signing it as your agent.

If then you are the heating contractor there, please have this application filed completely and the fee paid at this office at least by January 3, 1940. If you have had nothing to do with this job in the way of installing it, and know who did, will you be kind enough to advise this department so that we may take the matter up with the proper party.

Dear Mr. Warren:

Please note the above. Our inspector found several holes around steam riser pipes and kitchen sink drain and stack where they pass through the first floor. Fire stops are required around these pipes to make the openings tight. We shall have to hold you, as owner, responsible for fixing this situation. The owner is finally responsible anyway, and of course particularly so in this case because your contractor who applied for the building permit as your agent is no longer living. Please have these matters fully taken care of, so that when everything is in order we may be in position to issue the legal certificate of occupancy required by State Law as soon as you may desire to occupy the building.
