Also it appears that the lots which you have numbered 118 and 55 do not have the minimum with of 60 feet stimulated by Section 13-I applying to Residence AA Zonce, although it appears that No. 55 may be all right in the lot lines as now indicated are the same as the lines of the same lot on January 1, 1946. Apparently Lot 118 represents a subjivision of a much larger lot of record on January 1, 1946.
