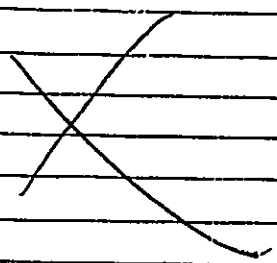

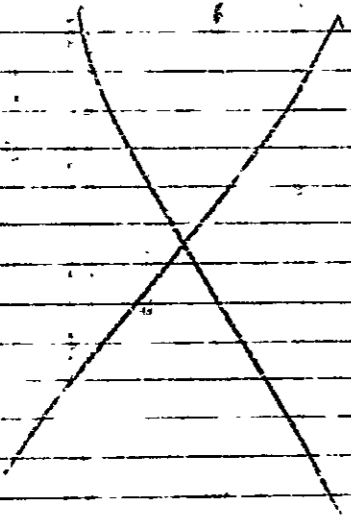

Dear Sir:

In the new dwelling of Nellie B. Foster at 116-124 Clifton Street, fire stops are needed in the basement around the sink drain and water pipes; the spring on the fire door between house and garage requires tightening so that it will close tightly and without fail; pointing up is required around the thimble where the smokepipe enters the chimney in the cellar.

Please have these matters all taken care of at least by March 24, 1933 and notify this office when they are finished so that another inspection may be made.

I note that the dwelling house has been occupied although no certificate of occupancy has been issued from this department as required by State law and by the Building Code. You, as contractor, ought to have notified this office for final inspection sufficient season so that we could have made the inspection, had whatever deficiencies that were found corrected, and the certificate of occupancy actually issued to the owner before the building was finally occupied.

It is true that we notified the owner by mail on December 15th of this requirement for final inspection and certificate of occupancy, but I feel that you, as contractor, ought to be informed about these requirements and to have notified us irrespective of whether or not the owner did.

We are not trying to embarrass anybody, but I am emphasizing this point so that in future jobs you will be sure to take care of this final notice.

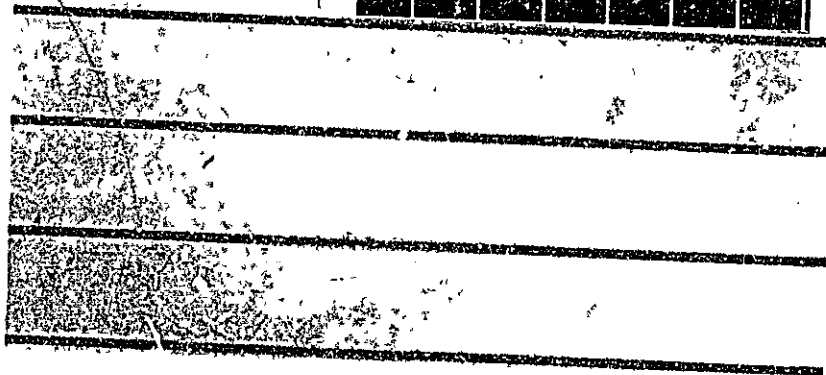
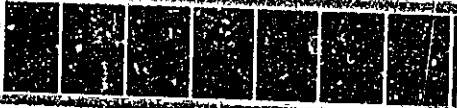
