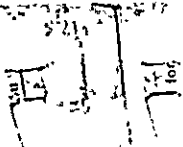

Dear Sir:

With relation to the three new dwelling houses for which you have been issued building permits at 55-37 Codman Street, 43-45 Codman Street and 39-41 Codman Street, when the concrete forms for the foundation walls have been constructed for any or all of these houses, please notify this office for inspection before any concrete is poured in the forms, and refrain from pouring any concrete until we have again checked the location of the houses.

The reason for this check upon the locations is that, due to present dry methods of excavation, the stakes or batter boards are often knocked out of position during the excavation, and we have even had cases where a building was not built in the precise location where we had originally checked it. It is easy to see that this discrepancy might make a serious situation for the owner and a cause for controversy on the part of neighboring owners.

It seems best, therefore, for us to check the location again when the actual location has been irrevocably established.
