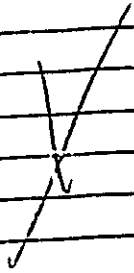

Gentlemen:

Permit for the above work is issued herewith subject to
the following:

1. The concrete piers are required to extend at least 6" above the surface of the ground surrounding them.
2. The girders supporting the center of each floor are required to be no less than 6x6 or 4x8 instead of 4x4. The 2x6 floor timbers are to be supported on 2x3 nailin^g strips spiked to sides of joists and girders and over which they may be notched.
3. Corner and intermediate posts of rear platform are required to extend full length from sill to plate, if splices are necessary, they must be at least 1' long and occur just above the second floor level. Care should be taken in supporting second floor framing on these posts that they are not crushed excessively.
