Dear Sir:

Upon examination of an oil burner installation in the building which you are reported to own in this city at 15 Amherst Street, an inspector from this office discovered that there was no cleanout door at the bottom of the chimney flue. We feel that the oil burner installer is in no way responsible for this, but that no doubt this deficiency in the chimney has always existed.

According to building code standards there should be provided at the bottom of the chimney flue a cast iron cleanout door and frame so that the chimney flue may readily be cleaned out, and so that more ready access may be had to the chimney in case of a fire in the flue itself.

Will you be kind enough to attend to this matter on or before February 10, 1937?

11/28/33 - Wooden floor on top of concrete floor is cut tightly against base of heater. Oil burner enters heater through ash pit door opening so that heat is in former ash pit which is lined with fire brick. These bricks get red hot directly opposite the nozzle of the burner when burner is running. At time of inspection, shortly after burner had shut down, cast iron base of heater was so warm in rear that I could hardly hold my hand on it. Smoke pipe from heater, which is 10" in diameter, runs beside wooden partition and only between 9" & 10" away from it. There are evidences that this partition has been rather warm at times as shown by yellowing and almost

Dear Mr. Knowlton:

Upon inspection of the oil burner recently installed at 15 Amherst Street, we found the installation itself to be apparently satisfactory, but some conditions exist with regard to the heater of which I think you should be advised.

The 10-inch smokepipe from the heater to the chimney runs beside a wooden partition and only about nine or ten inches away from the partition. There are evidences that this partition has been very warm at times. The tendency of the oil burner is to heat the smokepipe more than ordinary hard fuel. I suggest that you have a piece of asbestos reinforced with metal suspended about half-way between the smokepipe and the partition to make sure that no trouble will ensue.

It appears that you have a wooden floor over the concrete floor in the cellar, and at the time of inspection, this wooden floor was cut tightly against the base of the heater. The oil burner operates in the ash pit of the heater, and, although the ash pit is lined with fire brick, a very intense heat is present when the oil burner is in full blast. The inspector reports that the base of the heater was quite hot on the outside when he was there. I would suggest that you cut this wooden flooring back so that it will be from six inches to a foot away from the base of the heater all around.

I am sure that you will understand that these suggestions are made with the safety of your home in mind.

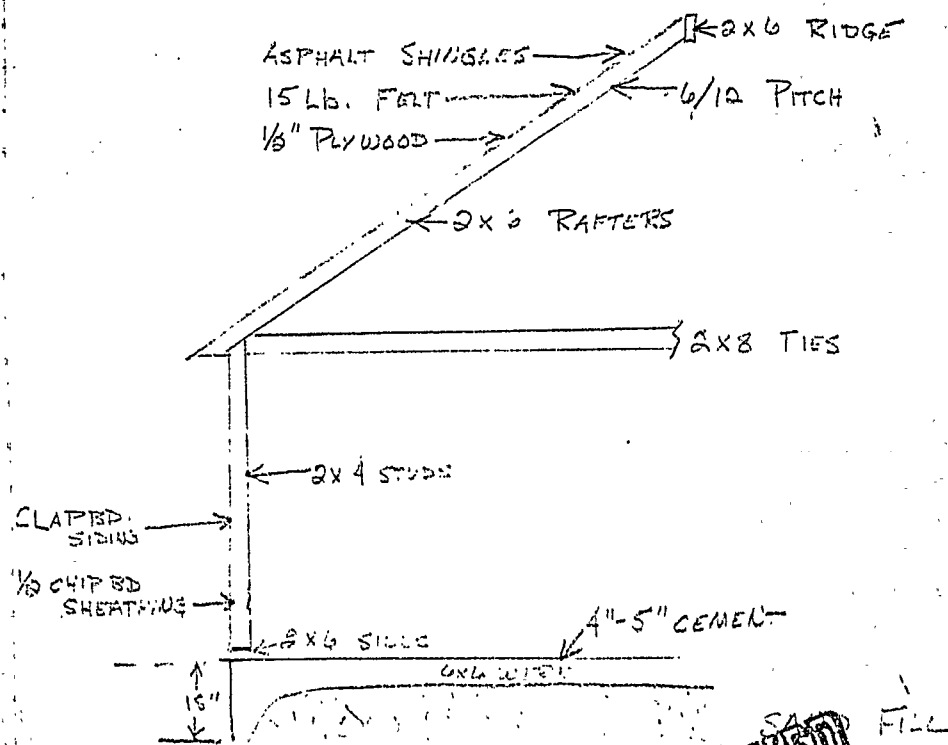

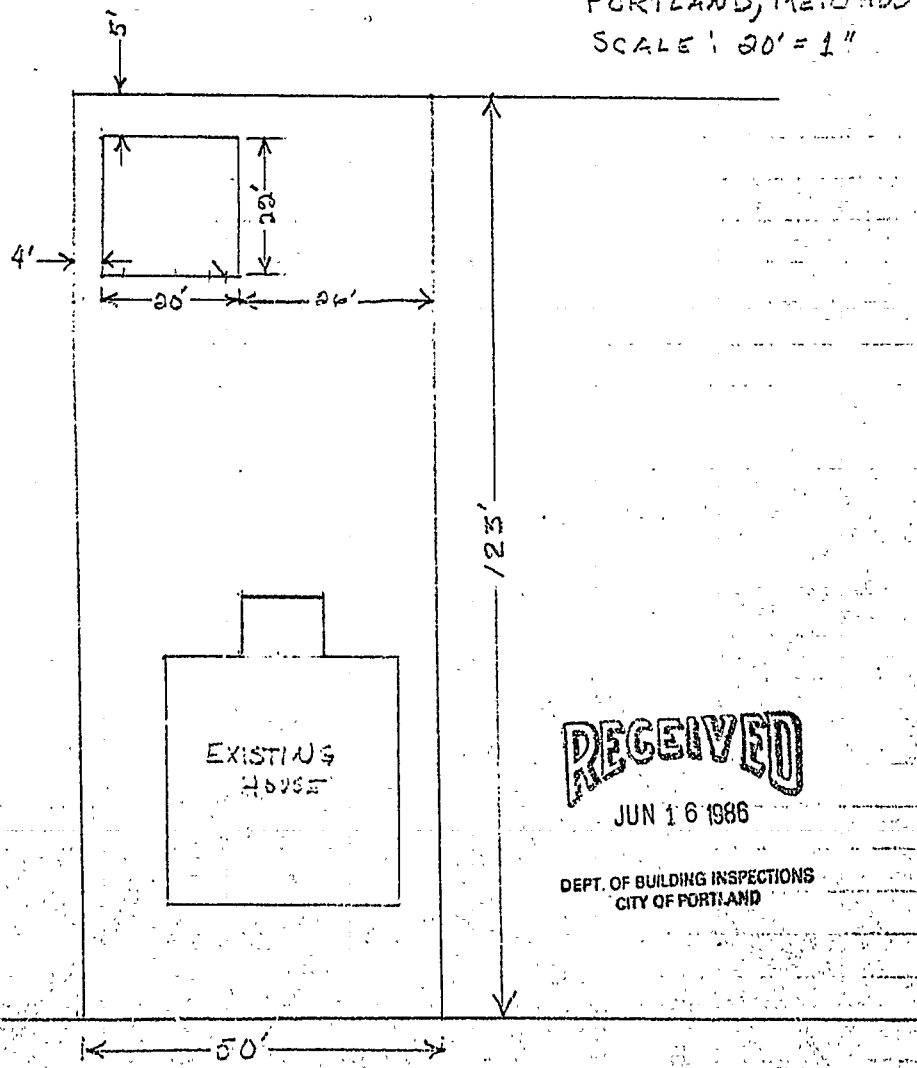
