EXISTING VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 307 - "MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR HOUSING" -

1. Point up stone step of front entrance doorway.
2. Repair or replace the loose and worn front entrance door.
3. Determine the reason and remedy the condition which causes the signs of leakage on the left, right and rear cement wall foundation in the cellar.
4. Repair or replace the loose and worn tile on the cellar floor.
5. Repair or replace the worn sash, frames and loose windows in the kitchen, living room; the left rear and left front bedrooms.
6. Repair or replace the loose plaster on the ceiling of the living room.
