EXISTING VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 307 - "MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR HOUSING"

1. Repair or replace the loose railing on the front porch.
2. Properly connect the loose drain pipe at the rear of the structure.
3. Repair or replace the loose windows in the kitchen, bathroom,
living room, dining room, den and office on the first floor; the
right front, left front, left middle bedroom and the right middle
sitting room on the second floor.
4. Repair or replace the broken plaster on the walls in the bathroom.
5. Repair or replace the loose toilet, the worn and chipped lavatory
and the bathtub in the bathroom.
