
To Whom It May Concern:

On two previous occasions this office has contacted your development project through the management to express objection to the sign which is visible from Baxter Boulevard which offers your units for rental or lease. We have also informed your manager that there is no provision in the Zoning Ordinance for a sign in the R-3 Residence Zone, which is visible from Baxter Boulevard.

Due to the park-like status of the Boulevard, this office has previously requested that the sign be removed from the Boulevard side of your project. The sign identifying Back Cove Estates on the Ocean Avenue frontage is the only sign which is permitted for your development project. Any other signs should be removed.

We shall expect compliance with this request within ten days following the receipt of this letter. Failure to comply will result in our referring the matter to the office of the City's Corporation Counsel for enforcement.

SUBJECT: Back Cove Estates has a Sign in Violation of the Zoning Ordinance

On the side toward Baxter Boulevard, there is a sign for which no permit has been issued and which offers condo or apartment units for lease at Back Cove Estates.

The Zoning Ordinance does not allow more than 15 square feet of signage in the R-3 Residence Zone for an establishment, and this has been used by the identification sign on the Ocean Avenue side of the development.

We have had several complaints concerning the sign which is visible from the Baxter Boulevard even though it is located on private property. Such signs should not be permitted to distract the motorists on the Baxter Boulevard and should therefore be removed. The Boulevard is dedicated park land.

A recent letter to the Manager of the Back Cove Estates was sent to the office of the Manager, but only one of the two signs formerly located on the side toward the Boulevard was removed.

A permit was denied for such a sign and the existing sign should also be removed without further delay.

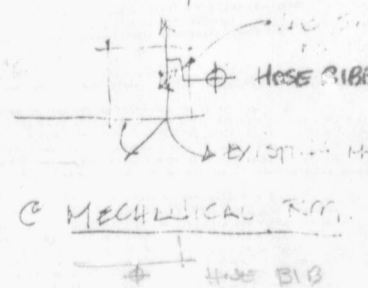
