

Dear Mr. Terry:

Permit to construct 1-story frame dwelling with attached two-car garage 75'x30'-8" is being issued subject to plans received with application and in compliance with Building Code restrictions as follows:

1. Sills are to be bolted at corners and not more than six feet from center to center between corners.
2. Row of cross bridging or block bridging shall be installed at mid-span of floor joists.
3. Floor joists running parallel to non-bearing partitions and intended to support them shall be doubled wherever the net vertical area of the partition is 80 square feet or more.
4. A self closer is required on solid core door from the dwelling to the garage area.

In reply to your letter of April 12th to Mr. Nelson Terry of 69 Falmouth Street, of which we received a copy, we submit the following information:

1. Roof framing construction: Valley R. 2-2x10"; Main House Hip 2-2x10 with support post; Ell Hip 2-2x8; 2"x6" Roof Ties @ 1/3 point - 16" o.c.
2. Front rafters of ell will rest on 4x10 Headers: Ell roof supports on front of dwelling will be 4x6 wooden posts.
3. 14-6 4"x10" Fir ceiling joists between living and dining rooms are supported by 4x6 posts.
4. Step down from the kitchen to garage floor will be 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " risers or 15".




