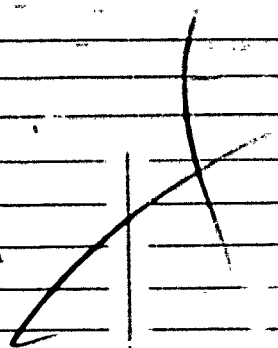

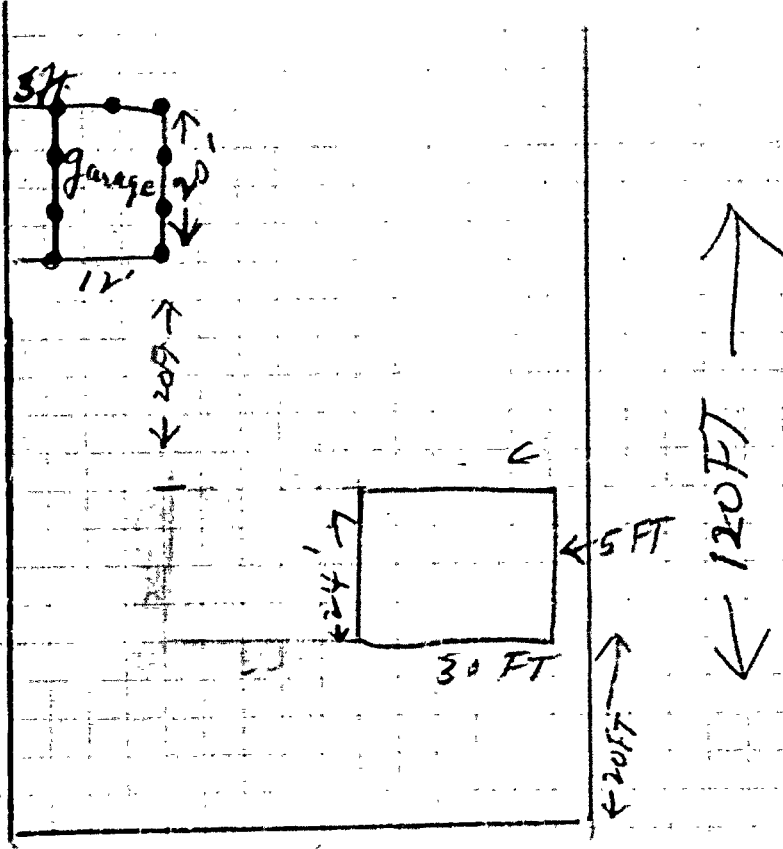

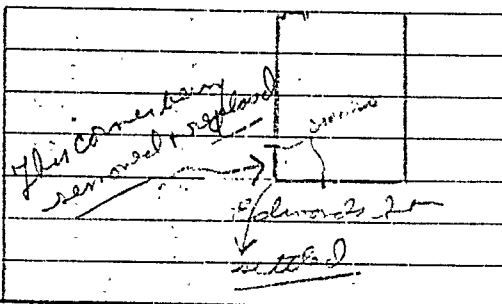

Gentlemen:

While the application for the permit states that there will be about 2' 6" clearance between top of furnace and the woodwork above, it is the usual practice to provide a plenum chamber on top of the furnace in cases where the air is circulated through the system by a fan. In such a case the top of the plenum chamber is required to have a clearance of at least 15" from the woodwork above or may be placed no closer than 4" to the woodwork if a shield of asbestos lumber extending at least 2" beyond the edges of the chamber on all sides is suspended between the top of the chamber and the woodwork.
