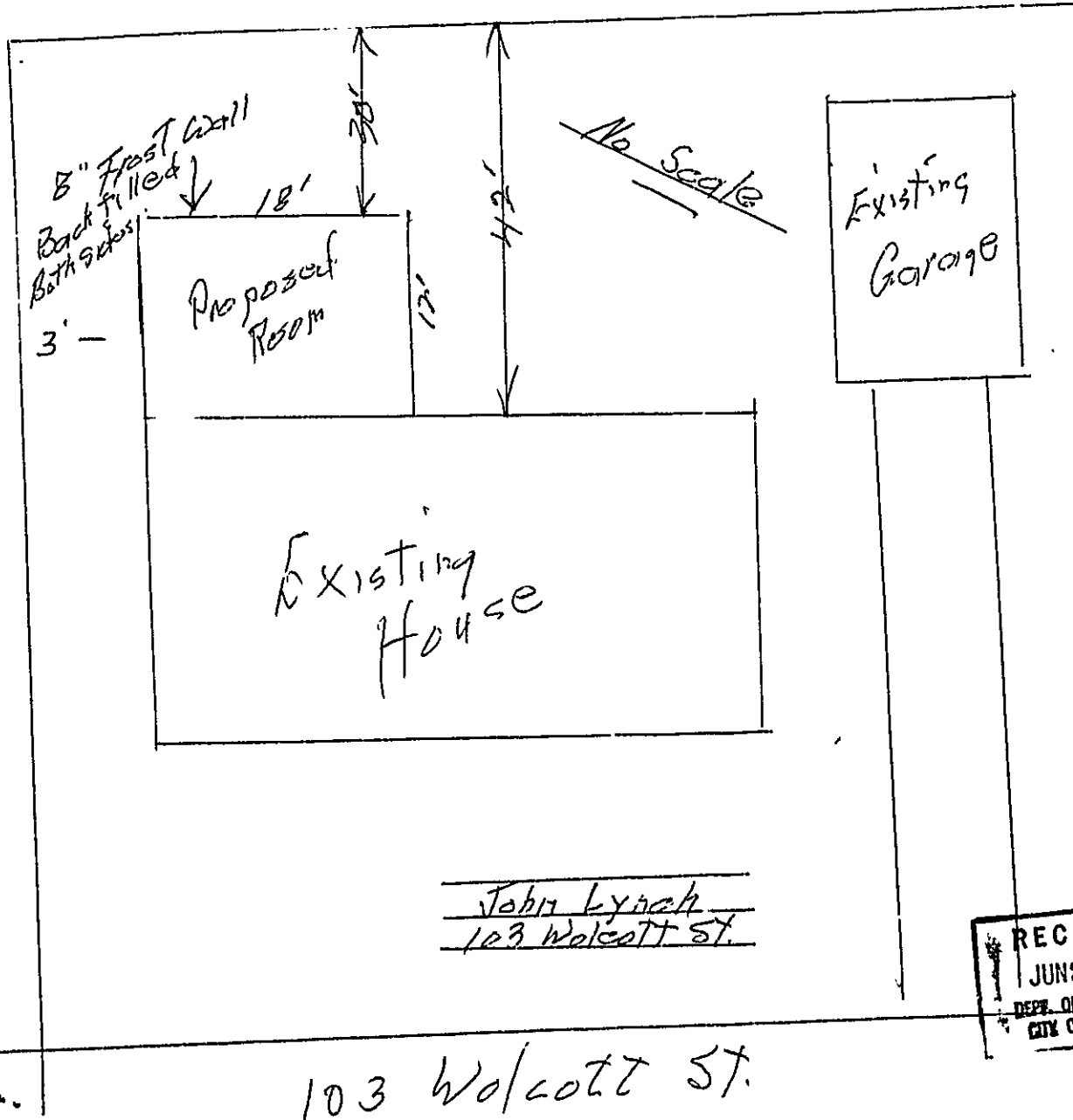

Permit to construct a rear dormer approximately 39 feet in length and to finish off one room on second floor is being issued subject to the framing being strengthened to meet Building Code design roof load as follows:

1. The new built-up structural ridge which will have clear spans of 12 and 13½ feet between supports in partitions will need to be made up of three 2x10-inch members rather than three 2x8-inch members as shown.
2. Rafters will need to be 2x10 inch members spaced at 16 inches on centers rather than 2x8 inch members as shown.
