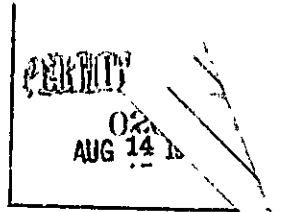

Dear Sir:

Permit for the above work is issued herewith subject to the following:

1. The garage side of the partition separating it from the balance of the cellar and the under side of the first floor joists exposed in the garage area will be covered with perforated Gypsum lath to which Gypsum plaster at least $\frac{1}{2}$ inch in thickness will be applied.
2. Any opening in this partition will be covered by self-closing fire doors and frames, these doors either being labelled by the Underwriters Laboratories Inc. for use in openings in corridor or room partitions are to be constructed as specified for a standard fire resistant door in Section 303c4 of the Building Code. A raised threshold at least six inches higher than the level of the garage floor will be provided in such openings.

After the studs of the partition have been erected and strapping applied to the ceiling, you should notify this office for a closing-in inspection before any lathing is done.

Although this building has been occupied for some time, we have never received notification for the final inspection which is required before a certificate of occupancy is issued. An inspector from this department reports that about the only things requiring attention in the cellar are firestopping of pipes at the floor line where they pass up into partitions and the fastening of the tops of the columns beneath girders to the girders themselves. Our records do not show that a permit ever was issued for the installation of the heating plant in the building. While not disposed to raise the question of permit requirement at this late date, we would appreciate it if you would inform us as to who made the installation.
