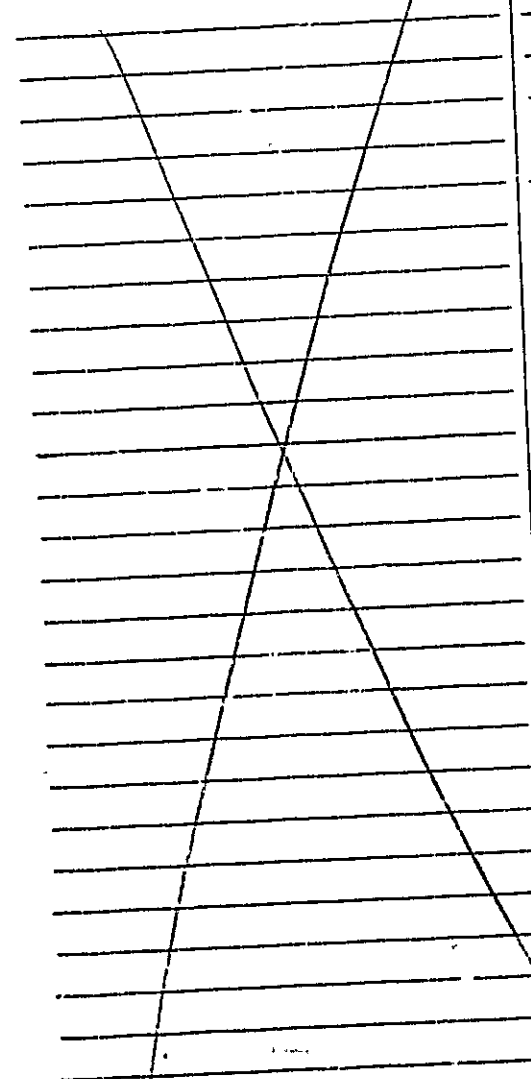

It is understood that the State requirement that all exit doors shall swing outwards, includes the front entrance doors and perhaps the exterior doors at either end of the first floor. It is likely that swinging these doors outwards would mean that there would be a step down under the outward swing of the door. If that is the case, a day to day accident hazard would be set up well recognized by Liability Insurance people. While we have nothing in the Building Code which specifically forbids such a situation, it is suggested that those responsible for the Home may desire to contact the Director of Fire Prevention in Augusta to see if he would not prefer to leave these doors which are used right along for entrance and exit also, as they are, rather than subject to people using the doors regularly to this well recognized accident hazard of only one step at a single spot and that under the outward swing of a door.

The plan with the application indicates that there is to be installed a manual fire alarm system. If it is truly a manual system, no separate permit for its installation is required from this department; but, if it should turn out that this system is automatic, a separate permit from this department is required, that permit to be applied for by affissuable only to the actual installer.

It appears that the upper landing of the upper wooden part of the fire escapes on each end of the building, evidently having been there for many years, was supported in an unusual way when the platforms were built, in that the only support seems to be the run of stairs downward and the bearing of the platform joists on the roof of the building. Since these platforms are evidently fairly old, it is recommended that the Home have them thoroughly examined and if they do not appear to be permanently safe to take steps to make them so. *Same*

Gentlemen:

Replying to your inquiry of November 7 concerning proposed alterations to the fire escapes at the Eunice Frye Home on Capisic Street, I have been over this matter with the Chief of the Fire Department who approves the proposed arrangement.

I see no reason then why you may not proceed with the work, applying and securing a permit, of course, before the work is started. I presume that the detailed construction and arrangement will satisfy the Building Code requirements for standard fire escapes as regards limited pitch of the stairs, safe load, through bolts, etc. The plan is not sufficiently in detail to make certain of these matters.
