These plantings shall extend for a length of one hundred feet (100') along the entrance road, or as otherwise directed by the Engineer.
All waste areas and entrances to waste area shall be uniformly graded to drain, loaned or covered with other earthy material that will support a growth of grass, seeded and hay nulched.
All trees which are damaged, uprocted or otherwise moved as a result of the waste material, and trees which have had waste material placed around them to the extent that they will die, shall be cut and removed.
Grading, Loaming, Seeding, Hay Mulching, Replanting of Trees and Tree Removal shall not be paid for directly, but shall be incidental to other items in the contract.

Thank *your for meeting with me last week at the site of the proposed Masonic Temple on Congress Street.

As we discussed, we are looking for properties available to accept excess fill material being generated during the reconstruction of Congr 's Street. From our discussions it appears your site could take fill to fit your future plans. We are willing to deposit excess material with your concurrence.

The fill material will generally consist of a mixture of gravel, sand and clay materials. There will be no demolition materials or debris. We will begin placing fill at the top of the hill, leveling out the area heading away from Congress Street. The fill will be placed no higher than the existing high point of the land. We understand the full width of the property is available and we will keep a safe distance from the brook at the bottom of the hill, as directed by a statement of the environmental resources division. All representative be placed in compliance with local and state result sions.

The fill will be graded to drain so no low areas to colle " water will exist. Upon completion the entire fill area will be seeded and mulched to stabilize the area. The existing paved dri reway may be further damaged by the heavy loads, but we understand this is not of great concern because it will be replaced with the new construction. Please let us know of any other requirements you may have.

If the depositing of fill on the Masonic Temple property as outlined above is acceptable to you, please sign and return a copy of this letter. Thank you for your consideration.

We feel this would be in everyone's best interest to reduce any illegal dumping, have just one responsible party and to keep the site well graded and controlled. Sites with everyone dumping inevitably end up with problems and complaints.
