We are unable to issue a permit for construction of a proposed two car garage and connection to dwelling on lot at 407 Capisic St. because so much of the so-called "brezeway" is to have enclosing walls that protection is required on the wall of the garage adjoining the "brezeway" and a self-closing fire door or solid wood core door at least 1 3/4 inches thick is required on the opening in this protected wall. No such protection is indicated in the application for permit nor on the plan filed therewith.

This protection is required to extend from a point at least five feet beyond the rear wall of the "brezeway" around the corner to the edge of the window in the front wall of garage and from the bottom of the sill to such a height as to cut off the garage space from the roof of "brezeway". Unless there is to be at least a six inch step up from floor of garage to floor of "brezeway", a raised threshold of at least that height is required in the doorway where the door is to be hung.

Please furnish information as to the type of protection and fire door to be installed to meet Building Code requirements.

BP 407 Capisic St.--Violation of Building Code relating to fire protection for attached garage

Mr. Earle Young
407 Capisic St.

Dear Mr. Young:

We have been hoping without avail that you would see fit to correct this violation of law without unpleasant pressure; but the record shows that you have been thoroughly advised of what the requirements are, that except for the required fire protection the job was practically completed last September, and that you are apparently using the garage for parking your automobile. Four inspections, the last on April 7, showed that the fire protection had not been provided.

Now, Mr. Young, whether you believe this fire protection isn't needed to protect primarily your own family and your own home from a sudden fire in the garage, it is a requirement of law based on the recommendations of the best known safety organizations in the nation. Furthermore, by acceptance of the permit and starting the work you agreed to provide it.

We shall expect you to place your building and yourself in compliance with the law by providing all of this required fire protection before May 2, or we shall certainly seek the assistance of the City Legal Department to compel compliance--an unpleasant step for all of us and one which still would not make good the violation.

It may be that you have lost track of the letters which told you what the requirements are besides the threshold under the door raised six inches above the level of the garage floor, which has already been provided.

Instead of the ordinary door which you have, a solid core wood door with a uniform nominal thickness of no less than one and three-quarter inches is to be provided, and is to be equipped with a self-closing device which will keep the door normally in the closed position.

Last June you decided to use three-eighths inch thick or 2-ply 3/16 inch asbestos board for the wall protection inside the garage. This protection is to be provided on the garage side running from garage floor to roof boards of the garage, and from a point near a garage window at least five feet beyond the rear wall of the "breezeway", extending over and under the doorway between garage and breezeway, thence to the front corner of the garage and around that corner to the edge of the window in the front wall of the garage.

If the sheets of asbestos and cement to be used cannot be procured in the 3/8 inch thickness, it is acceptable if two layers of 3/16 inch material are used with the joints in each layer staggered. Area to be covered with this material is to be as indicated in our letter of June 2, 1954 and a six inch raised threshold is to be provided in the opening in protected wall.

The 1 3/4 inch thick wood door on this opening is to be a manufactured solid wood core door and is to be equipped with a self-closing device.

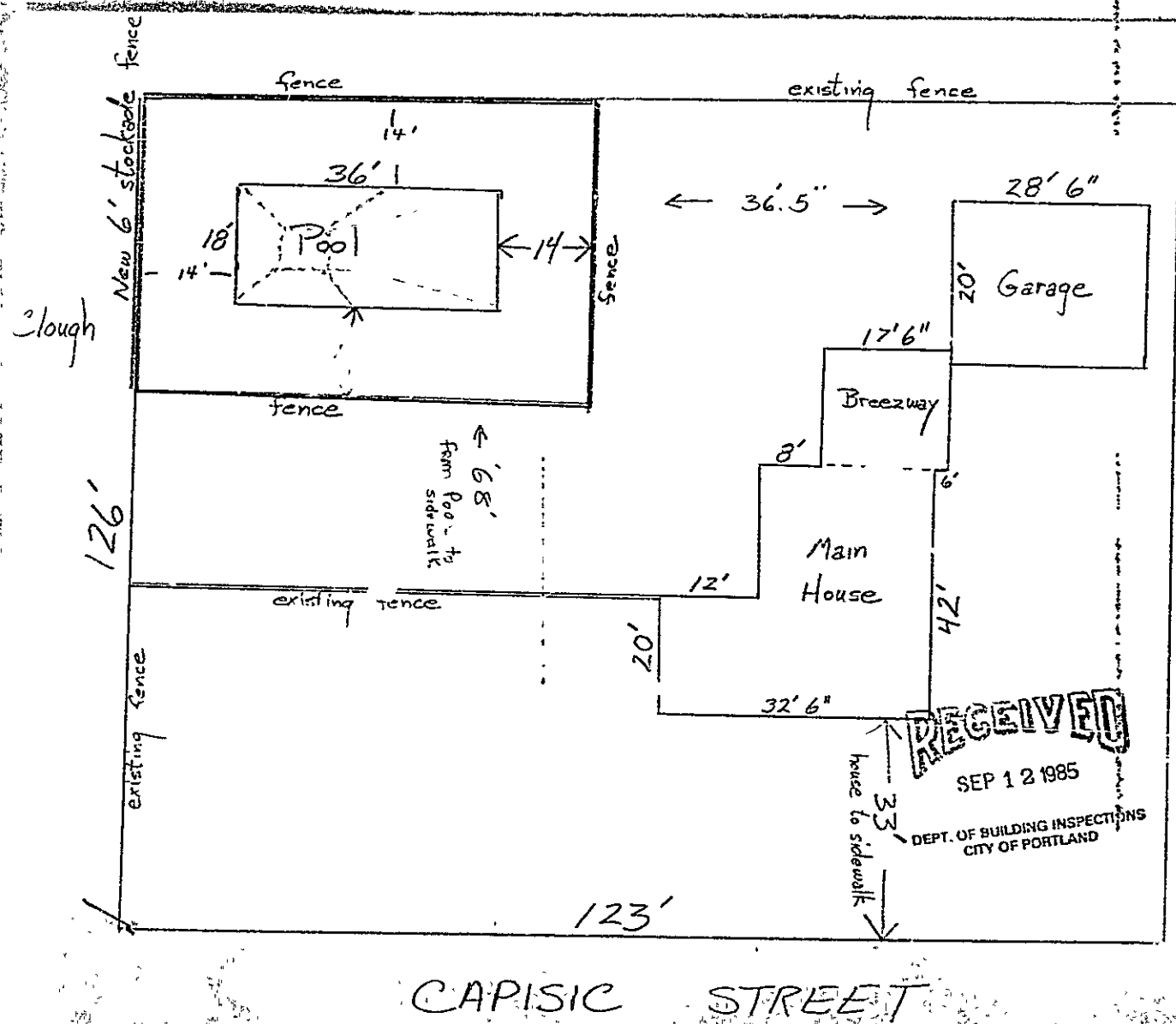

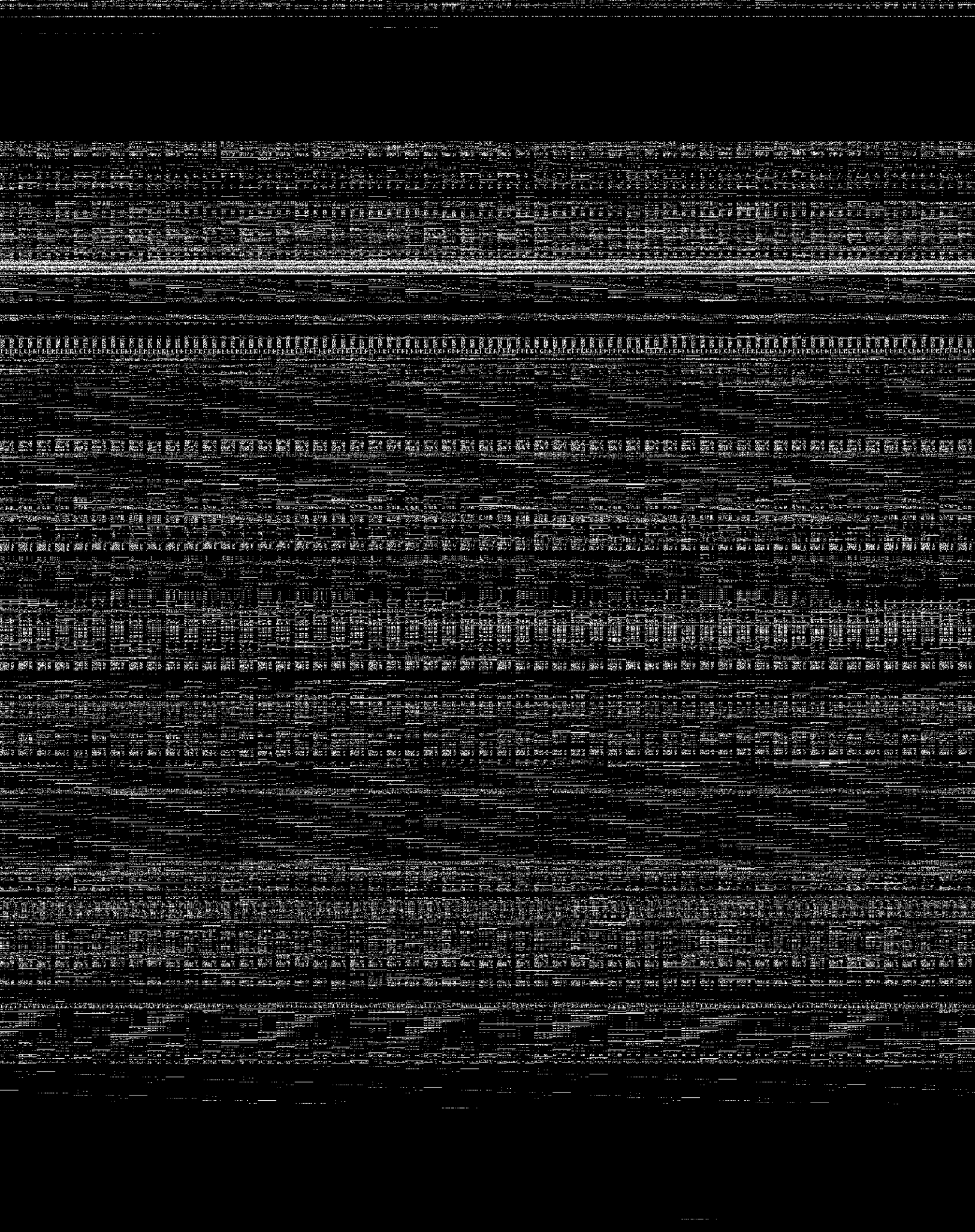

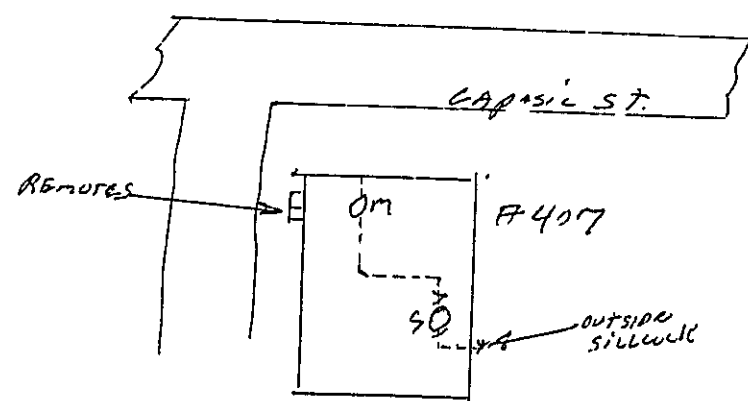
