2. Your plan shows frost wall construction for the foundation, therefore framing members are subject to decay damage and shall be of approved species and grade lumber, pressure preservative treated in accordance with standards in Section 26.308 of the building code.
3. Attached private garages shall be completely separated from adjacent interior spaces and the attic area by means of 1/2 inch gypsum board or equivalent applied to the garage side. The sill of all door openings between the garage and adjacent interior spaces shall be raised not less than 4 inches above the garage floor. The door opening protectives shall be 1 3/4 inch solid core wood door or approved equivalent.

4. Single family dwelling units (Use Group R-3) may be located above or adjacent to other single family dwelling units (Use Group R-3) provided each dwelling unit is completely separated from the adjacent dwelling units by fire separation walls and floor/ceiling assemblies of not less than one hour fire resistance rated construction. All fire separation walls shall extend from the top of fire-resistance rated floor/ceiling assembly below to the fire-resistance rated floor/ceiling or roof/ceiling assembly above.
5. All interior party walls shall be so constructed as to meet the building code sections 715.1 through 715.4.
6. All roof members shall be designed to support a minimum of 50 lb. P.S.F. with a pitch of 0/12 to 6/12/
7. Please supply this office with BOCA approval on the metal chimney, fireplace, and the installation of same.
8. See attached building code sections 809.4 and 1716.3.4.
