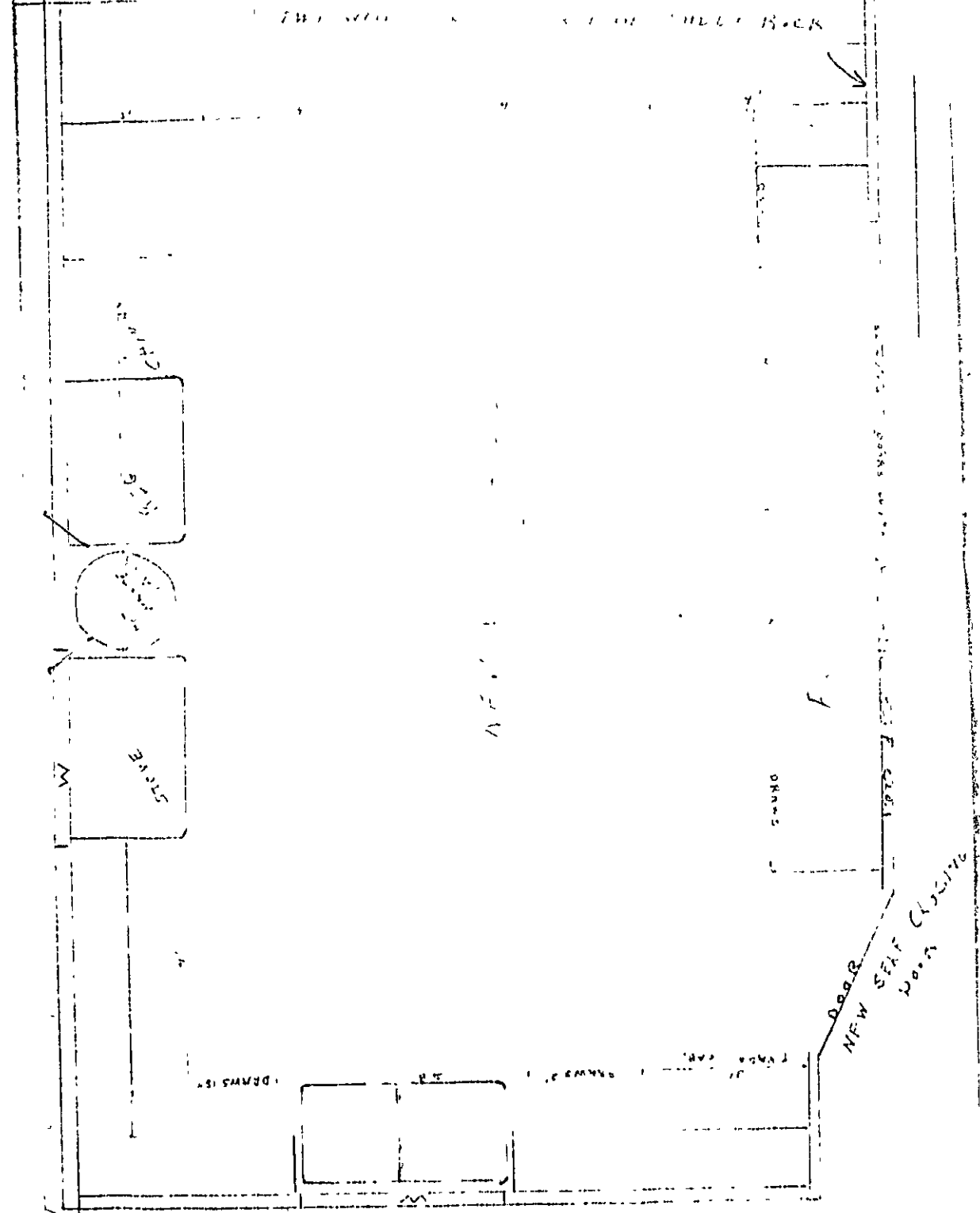
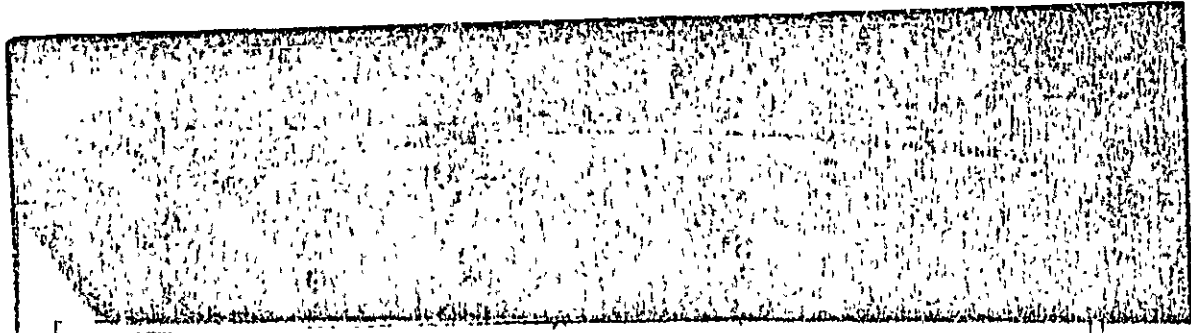

To Owner:

Please note that new partitions are required to have 2x3 studs not more than 16 inches on centers and running vertically. Care should be used in applying diagonal boards between heavy floor beams and large roof timbers, as they are intended to relieve floor timbers on a long span. They should be on both sides of timbers in each case.

To Fire Escape Contractor: Please note that the escape is understood to comply with requirements for standard fire escape. Note particularly that there must be at least 9 inches to edge of landing on each side of exit window.

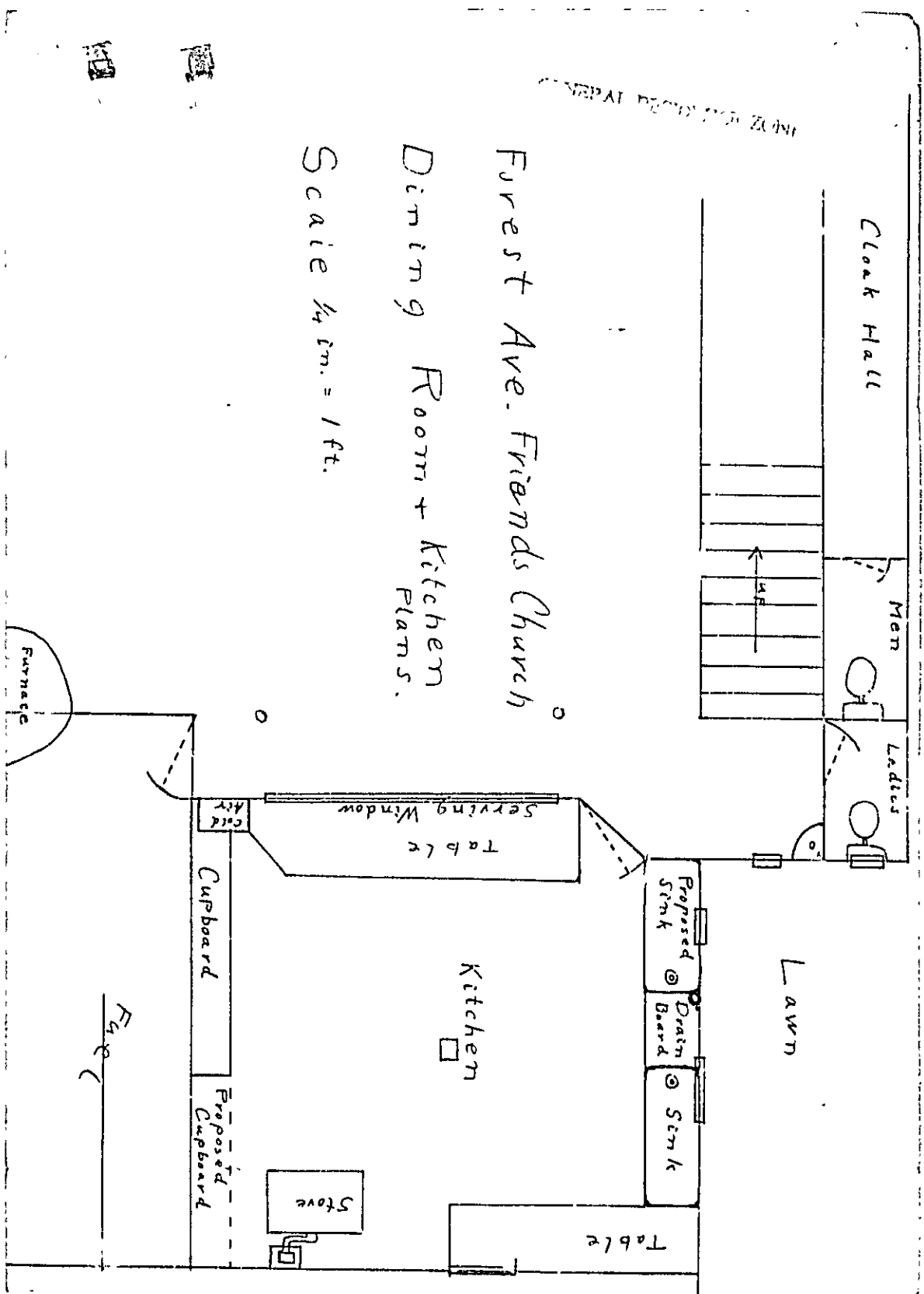

Dear Sir:

Inclosed is the building permit covering alterations in the Friend's Church at 1937 Forest Avenue. The following matters are called to your attention:

We are assuming that the interior stairs shown on the plan are to be the usual means of entrance to the basement assembly room and that these stairs are to be at least three feet in width between the hand rails, and that both stairways are to have hand rails on both sides of the stairs. Both stairways are required to be constructed with treads having non-slipping surfaces such as rubber mats or metal. If our assumption is correct with regard to the main entrance, anti-panic hardware will be required only on the exit which leads to the outside stairway and from there to the outside air. An anti-panic latch should be provided with bar or plate upon the door at the top of the outside stairs. No anti-panic bar will be required on the door at the foot of these stairs provided that only a latch operated by a knob with no locking device of any kind is used.

The metal lath and plaster ceiling over the heater is required to cover an area, the outside limits of which will be at least ten feet from all parts of the heating apparatus, fuel, breeching, and firing space.

It is assumed that one of the new toilet rooms will be designated for men and the other for women. The doors should be appropriately marked.

An exit light should be provided over the door leading to the outside stairs; this light should have a globe with the word "EXIT" on it in letters not less than one and one-half inches high. This light should glow red. There should also be one or more white lights in the outside stairway enclosure, and these lights and the exit light should be on a single and separate circuit and controlled by a single and separate switch.

If you desire to place the present heater in the room marked "Future Heating Room" at this time, only that portion of the ceiling over the heater room will be required to be covered with metal lath and plaster.

Before the new rooms are occupied, one fire extinguisher of one quart size, preferably using carbon tetra-chloride as an extinguishing agent should be provided near the heater.

A notification and inspection from this office is required before any of the work is closed-in with plaster or otherwise, and another notification and certificate of occupancy is required from this Department before the new part is finally occupied.

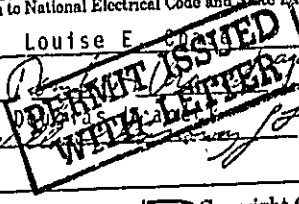

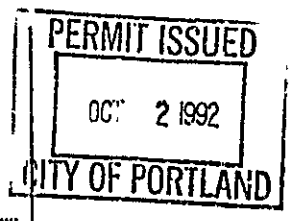

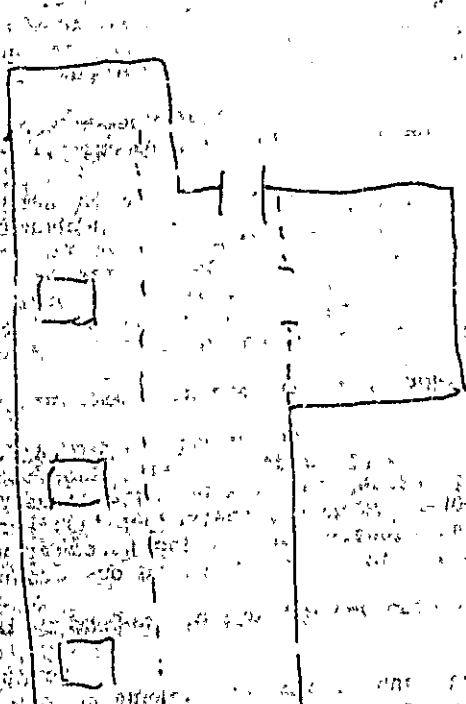

Subject: Zoning Amendments re Building Permits
and Unimproved Streets

Attached are the new zoning amendment permits and unimproved streets. The amendments enacted by the City Council. They take effect 12/31/84. Below are the answers to some frequently asked questions about the amendments:

Q. Who is subject to the new amendments?

A. Anyone who builds on a lot with frontage on an unimproved or an improved but unpaved street, regardless of whether it is accepted, dedicated, lapsed or abandoned. The amendments apply to residential and nonresidential buildings alike but not to accessory buildings or building additions. They also do not apply to the islands. Existing built-up lots are not affected.

Q. What improvements are required under the new amendments?

A. The street must be paved to the nearest paved street that is the principal access to the lot. Sewers, storm drains, and granite curbing must also be installed. The curbing requirement can be waived, however, if there is an acceptable drainage alternative. Sidewalks are also required if the street is a designated school walking route. All improvements must meet minimum City specifications.

Q. What are the requirements for lapsed and abandoned streets under the new amendments?

A. Lapsed and abandoned streets can be built upon if the lot owner surrenders his interest in the street to the City and signs an agreement waiving any claim for damages and indemnifying the City against any other claim for damages in case the City ever takes the street by eminent domain. (Under the current ordinance, lapsed and abandoned streets cannot be built upon unless the street is rededicated.) If the street is also unimproved or improved but unpaved, it must also be improved to minimum City specifications.

Q. Who is "grandfathered" under the new amendments?

A. Anyone who has been granted a building permit before December 19, 1984, and anyone who has applied for a permit before that date, as long as the street has already been

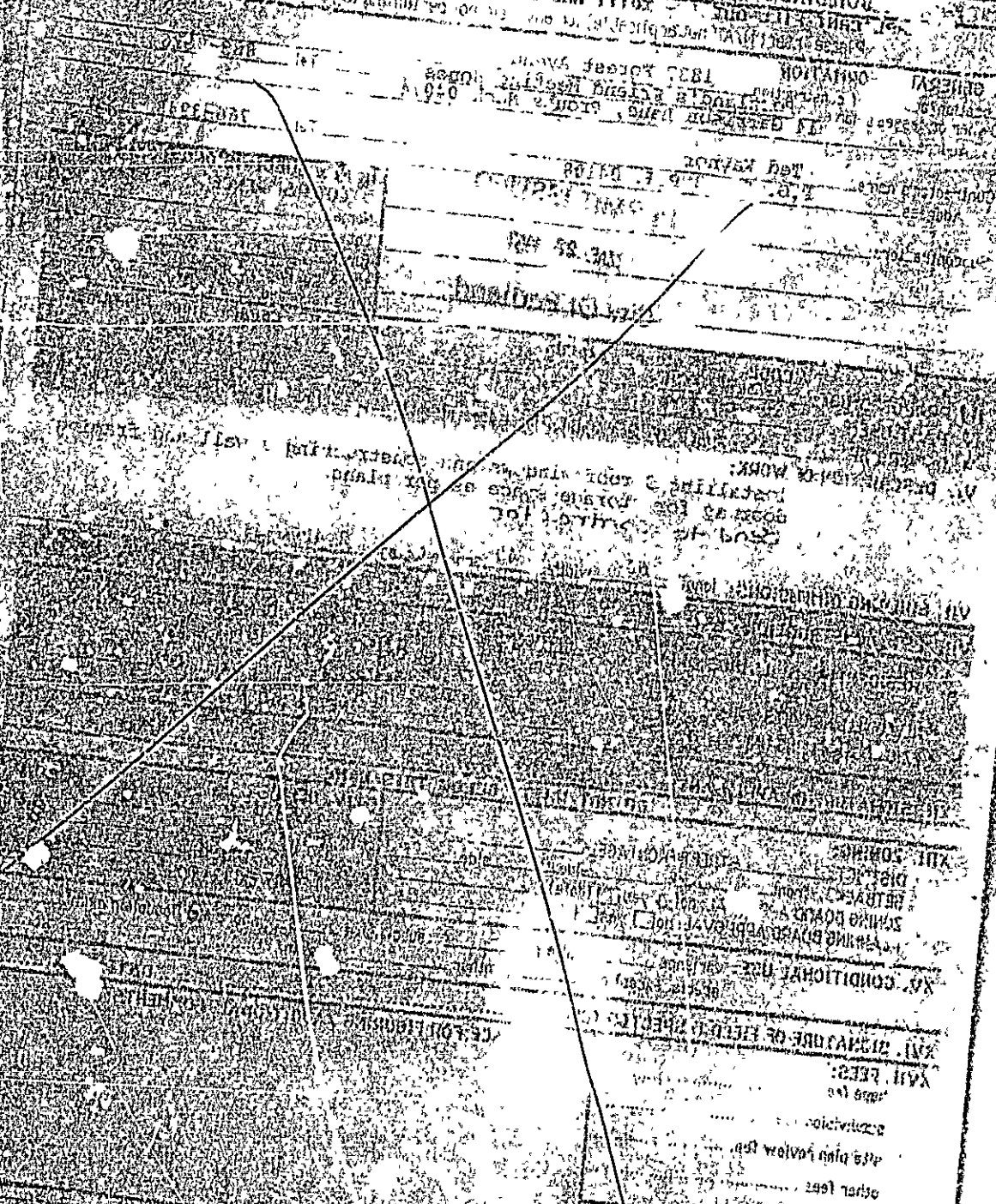


