A recent inspection at the above named address of which you are listed the present owner, showed that alterations have been completed, or are in the process of being completed, that require building permits from the City of Portland. This is a violation of the 1993 BOCA Building Code, Section 116.1; (unlawful acts): It shall be unlawful for any persons, firm or corporation to erect, construct, alter, extend, repair, remove, demolish or occupy any building or structure or equipment regulated by this code, or cause some to be done, in conflict with or in violation of any of the provisions of this code.

It is therefore necessary for you to come to City Hall, 389 Congress Street, Room 315, to file an application for these required permits. This must be accomplished with three(3) days of receipt of this letter. Failure to abide by this request could result in court action and a fine of up to \$500.00 to \$1,000.00 per day for each day this violation exists. I look forward to your prompt cooperation.

Dear Sir:

Your application to construct a 12'3" X 12' & 10' X 16' decks has been reviewed and a permit is herewith issued subject to the following requirements: This permit does not preclude he applicant from meeting applicable State and Federal laws.

- Building Code Requirements The rear yard setback has to be a minimum of 25.
- The side yard setback has to be a rinimum of 12'.
- Guardrails & Handrails A guardrail system of building components located near the open sides of elevated walking surfaces for the purpose of minimizing the possibility of an accidental fall from the walking surface to the lower level. Minimum height all Use Group 42", except Use Group R which is 36". In occupancies in Use Group A, B, H-4, I1, I-2 M and R and public garages and open parking structures, open guards shall have balusters or be of solid material such that a sphere with a diameter of 4" cannot pass through any opening. Guards shall not have an ornamental pattern that would provide a ladder effect.
- All exit signs, lights and means of egrees lighting shall be done in accordance with Chapter 10, section & subsections 1023. & 1925.0 of the City's building code. (The BOCA National building Code/1993)


