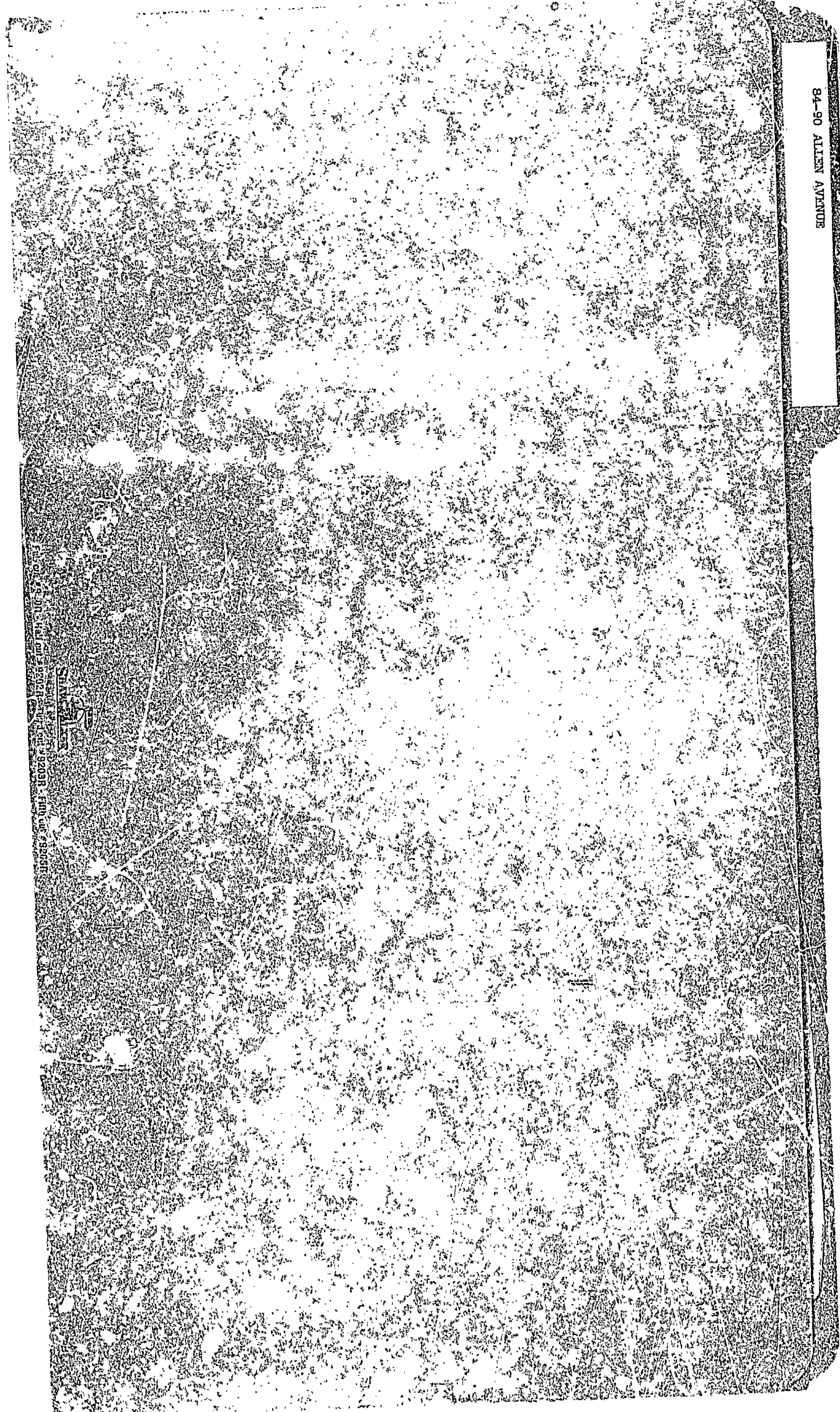

On December 13th, we wrote you concerning the condition of the smoke pipe and chimney in the building which you are reported to own at 88 Allen Avenue, stating in part as follows:

"It is necessary that you extend your chimney flue downwards to a good foundation at or about the cellar floor level, providing at the bottom of the flue a cast iron cleanout door and frame, and thus give the heating contractor an opportunity to connect the smoke pipe through the vertical side of the chimney which is the usual practice."

The condition referred to above is considered unsafe, and you have not only not paid any attention to our request above referred to, but have indicated that you do not plan to do anything about it, at least for the present.

You are hereby directed to have this condition corrected as outlined above on or before January 27, 1930. This order is given as authorized and directed by section 28 and section 32 of Chapter 30, Revised Statutes of Maine, copy of these sections being attached hereto.

Dear Sir:

Upon examination of the warm air furnace which the Portland Stove Foundry is installing in your building at 48 Allen Avenue, we find that the smoke pipe from the furnace has been connected to the chimney by means of entering the bottom of the chimney flue through the arch which apparently supports the chimney.

This is not considered a safe and adequate method as the cleanout of the chimney is not in the chimney itself, but in the smoke pipe, and naturally all the soot that is cleaned out of the chimney must naturally enter the smoke pipe first.

It is necessary that you extend your chimney flue downwards to a good foundation at or about the cellar floor level, providing at the bottom of the flue a cast-iron clean-out door and frame, and thus give the heating contractor an opportunity to connect the smoke pipe through the vertical side of the chimney which is the usual practice.

Please have this work done without delay, and notify this office when the same has been completed so that another inspection may be made.
