### VARIANCE APPEAL

September 14, 1959

Rudolph W. Kaserman , owner of property at 527-541 Auburn Street, corner Summit under the provisions of Section 24 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Portland, hereby respectfully petitions the Board of Appeals for a variance from the provisions of said Ordinance to permit: Rudolph W. Kaserman Erection of a detached temporary wood sign approximately 4 feet by 8 feet on vacant land at the above location, the sign to be owned by the Rufus H. Stone Co. but to advertise the Crest View Acres housing development under construction off Summit Street at the top of the hill. This permit is presently not issuable under Section 4-A of the Zoning Ordinance applying to the R-3 Residence Zone in which the property is located.

LEGAL BASIS OF APPEAL: Such variance may be granted only if the Board of Appeals finds that the strict application of the provisions of the Ordinance would result in undue hardship in the development of property which is inconsistent with the intent and purpose of the Ordinance; that there are exceptional or unique circumstances relating to the property that do not generally apply to other property in the same zone or neighborhood, which have not arisen as a result of action of the Ordinance or not; that property in the same zone or neighborhood with a result of action of of the Ordinance or not; that property in the same zone or neighborhood will not be adversely affected by the granting of the variance; and that the granting of the variance will not be adversely affected by the granting of the variance; and that the granting of the variance will not be contrary to the intent and purpose of the Ordinance.

## DECISION

ring held <u>October 1, 1959</u>, the Board of Appeals finds that all of the above exist with respect to this property and that a variance should be granted After public hearing held conditions do exist with respect to this property and that a variance should be granted in this case, for a period of not more than five years from the date hereof or until six months after completion of construction of this project, whichever is the sooner.

It is, therefore, determined that a variance from the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance should he granted in this case, as provided above.

The Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing in the Council Chamber at City Hall, Portland, Maine, on Thursday, October 1, 1959, at 4:00 p.m. to hear the appeal of Rudolph W. Kaserman requesting an exception to the Zoning Ordinance to permit erection of a detached temporary wood sign approximately 4 feet by 8 feet on vacant land at 527-541 Auburn Street, corner of Summit Street, the sign to be owned by the Rufus H. Stone Co., but to advertise the Crest View Acres housing development under construction off Summit Street at the top of the hill.

This permit is presently not issuable under Section 4-A or the Zoning Ordinance applying to the R-3 Residence Zone in which the property is located.

This appeal is taken under Section 24 of the Zoning Ordinance which provides that such variance may be granted only if the Board of Appeals finds that the strict application of the provisions of the Ordinance would result in undue hardship in the development of property which is inconsistent with the intent and purpose of the Ordinance; that there are exceptional or unique circumstances relating to the property that do not generally apply to other property in the same zone or neighborhood, which have not arisen as a result of action of the applicant subsequent to the adoption of this Ordinance whether in violation of the provisions of the Ordinance or not; that property in the same zone or neighborhood will not be adversely affected by the granting of the variance; and that the granting of the variance will not be contrary to the intent and purpose of the Ordinance.

All persons interested either for or against this appeal will be heard at the above time and place, this notice of required public hearing having been sent to the owners of property within 500 feet of the premises in question as required by the Ordinance.
