Enclosed is the building permit covering erection of a dwelling house combined with a one car private garage on Lot 1690-91 Allen Avenue.

Please pay particular attention to the following facts:

The plaster required as protection for the garage is Portland cement plaster as distinguished from gypsum plaster and should be applied by some person fully experienced in curing the same, otherwise cracks are liable to develop.

It is noted that you intend to use concrete blocks in the underpinning. You should bear in mind the fact that the law requires that these blocks be branded with a trademark of the manufacturer and that this trademark be registered in this department. Before purchasing these blocks, it would be well to make sure that they comply with this requirement.

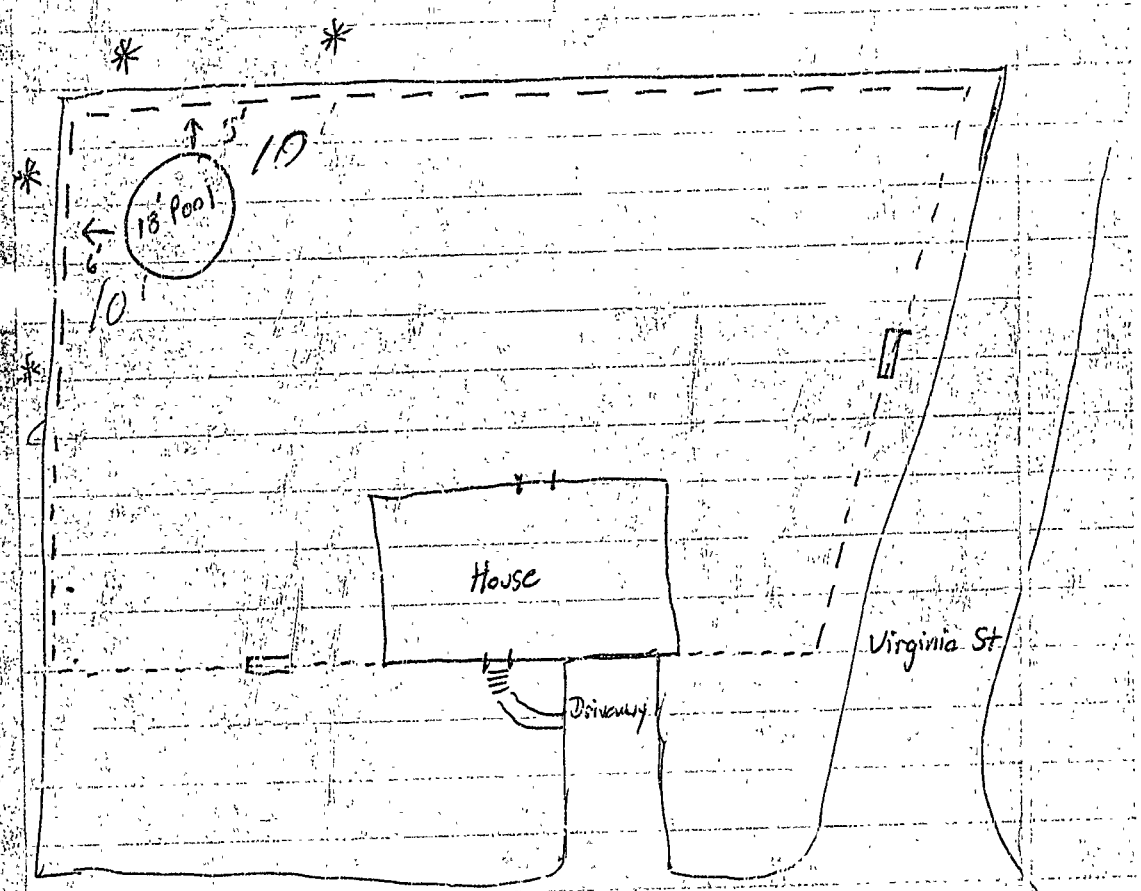

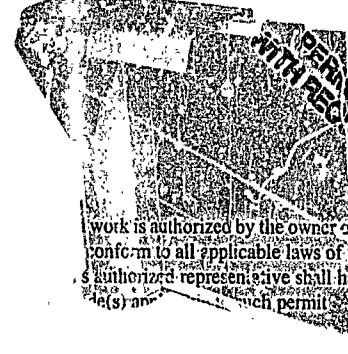

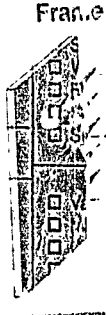
