

- 1. Repair the leaking flush toilet tank in the bathroom. 2. Reprir the loose light fixture on the kitchen ceiling.
- 3. Repair the leaking wastcline in the cellar.
- Replace the broken sashcords in the living room and dining room windows.

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Chapter 307 of the Nunicipal Code of the City of Portland, Mains, and must be corrected on or before April 15, 1979.

Passure to comply with this order may result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court.
