I am enclosing a copy of letter sent to Mr. Bruni, the owner of the land at the above address and am referring it to you for any action you deem necessary. As mentioned in the letter this was a case of surplus fill being dumped over onto the public way where the sidewalk should be and in turn making it difficult for children going to and from school. It is my understanding that this was reported to the City Manager through Dr. Wells and in turn was referred to me to do what I could about it.

This is really not a Building Code violation or a Zoning Code violation but I was asked to do what I could, and at this date no action has been taken by Mr. Bruni to have the earth properly put back on his own land. It is my feeling that perhaps the Public Works could assist in forcing this man to comply inasmuch as it is a street problem.

For some time there has been a surplus of fill which has been placed on your above mentioned property and in turn was also placed on the city's right-of-way or namely, sidewalk area. This has caused a great deal of hardship for the young people who are proceeding to school and have to walk in the street. Inasmuch as this is an encroachment which I am sure you would not like to have put upon your land if it were dumped over by others I am asking that with spring here you immediately employ a machine to remove this in proper fashion and put it where it belongs on your own land. I am forwarding this letter to the Corporation Counsel for any legal procedures they may deem necessary if you cannot comply with this within ten days of date of this letter.

Section 6 of the ordinance for rodent and vermin control provides: "It shall be unlawful to demolish any building or structure unless provision is made for rodent and vermin eradication. No permit for the demolition of a building or structure shall be issued by the Building Inspector until and unless provisions for rodent and vermin eradication have been carried out under supervision of a pest control operator registered with the Health Department.

The building permit for demolition cannot be issued until the provisions of this section have been satisfied. It is the obligation of owner or demolition contractor or both to take up with the Health Department the matter of complying with this section, being prepared to inform that department what registered pest control operator is to be employed.

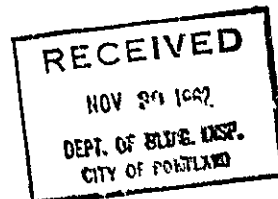
