Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the building permit covering cutting in double doors in the building of Albert S. Way at 75 Allen Avenue, and changing the use of the building from a poultry house to a single car garage.

Upon examination of the building on June 15th, an Inspector from this office found that the work had already been commenced and was practically finished although no permit had been issued from this office to cover the work.

This is the second or third time that we have found small jobs of this nature which you have either completed or commenced before the permit card was actually in your possession and posted upon the premises. You are no doubt aware of the fact that the permit card is to be in the possession of the owner or contractor and posted upon the premises before the work is commenced. I trust that you will see to it that permit cards are in your possession and posted upon the premises on all jobs in the future, large or small, before any of the work is commenced. This procedure will not only be a helpful bit of cooperation with this office, but will avoid any action on the part of the office for violation of the Building Code.

The Inspector also noticed that the building is not in a good condition, and that part of the building was no still. The building, of course, should be made substantial and satisfactory in every particular, and for this reason, we are sending a copy of this letter to the owner of the building.
