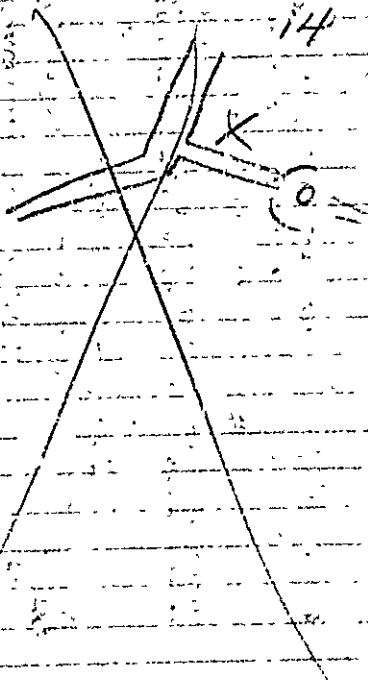
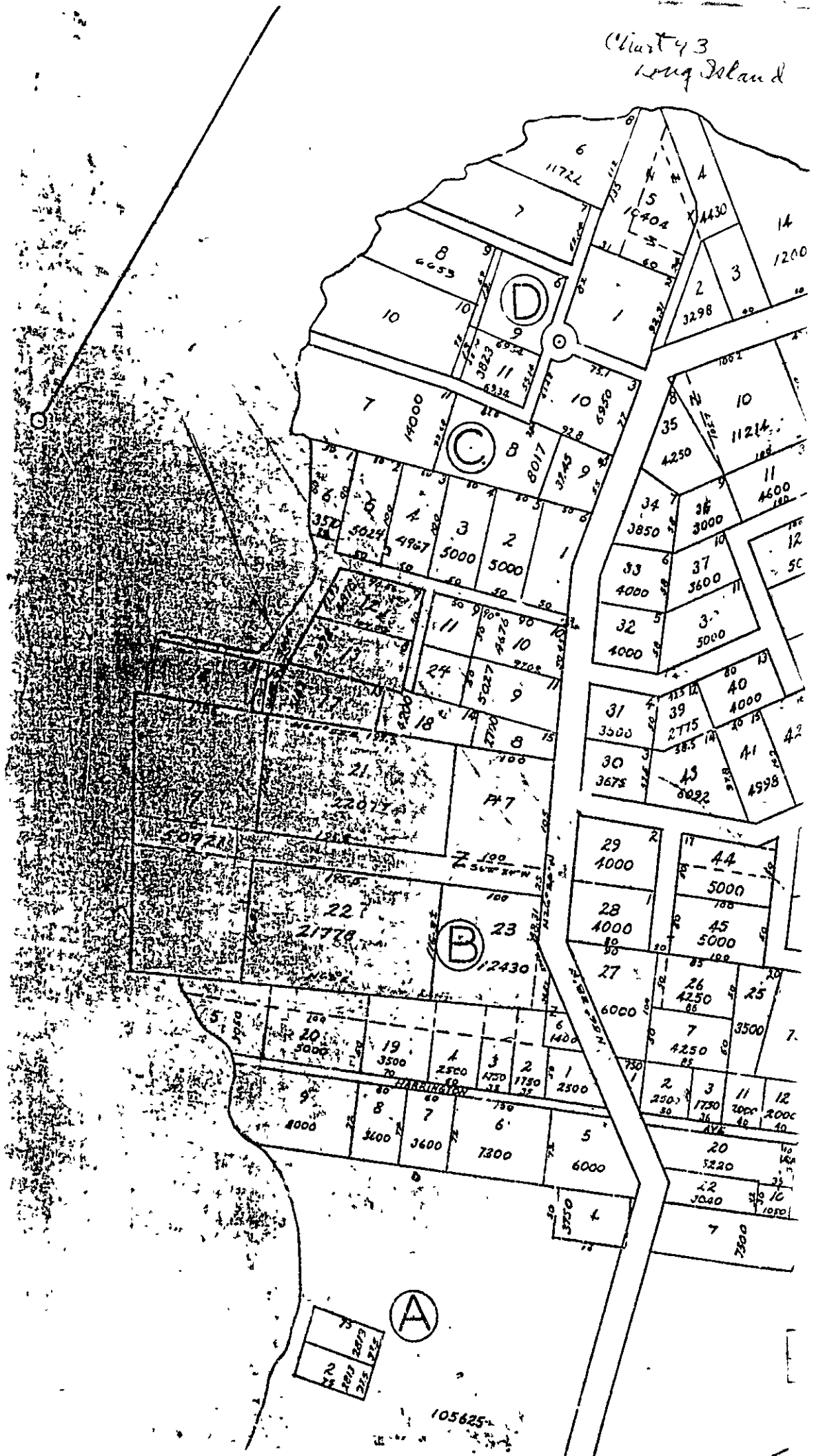


Per your request this letter lists what we are doing to the Jane Wray Larocque property on Long Island, L#93-B-16 & 17, Permit #0055:


