Dear Sir:

Enclosed is the building permit covering repairs to a wooden shingled roof on the building of Martha A. Merrill on Beach Avenue, Long Island.

The permit clerk in this office reports that you appear to be in some doubt as to whether or not wooden shingles can lawfully be used to make these repairs. The law provides that no more than ten per cent (10%) of the area of the existing roof may be repaired with wooden shingles in any one year, and you have signed a statement in this office to the effect that no more than ten per cent (10%) of the area will be repaired at this time.

We desire no misunderstanding with regard to this question. I would, therefore, recommend that you determine the dimensions of the existing roof and figure the total area; then determine the dimensions of the sections that you propose to repair and figure that area. If the area that you propose to repair is ten per cent (10%) of the total area or less than that, you are at liberty to proceed under this permit using wooden shingles. If, on the other hand, the area proposed to be repaired is more than ten per cent (10%) of the total roof area of the building, then you should return the permit promptly to this office and make arrangement to repair the roof with some other material than wooden shingles.
