Dear Sir:

I am sorry that we are unable to handle applications for building permits in the way that you suggest in your letter of April 8th relating to a minor alteration of your cottage on the east end of Long Island. It is necessary that some person, preferably the one who is to actually do the work, come to the office in person, fill in the necessary blanks on the application form, sign the form and pay the fee.

Our Building Code undertakes to say how an enclosure such as you propose of a portion of your piazza shall be built, and we have no option then to see that work is done according to the Ordinance. Assuming that the portion of the porch to be used for the storage of farm equipment is now in a substantial condition, the new walls are required to be built of studs no less than 2x4 spaced not more than 16 inches from center to center, and over the window and door openings would be required, if they are the ordinary width, double 2x4 headers supported under each end by short 2x4 "jack" studs. We shall also have to know the location of the building, especially the part of the porch to be enclosed with relation to the property line, and that information can best be given by a sketch, in proportion, which will show these necessary dimensions.

The fee is based upon the cost of the work, the cost representing the total estimated cost including all labor and material. Even though one did his own work or used material that he already owned, it is necessary to make a reasonable allowance for the cost of the labor and the value of the material. The fee is not upon a rational basis, but runs as follows:

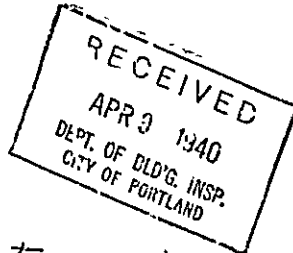

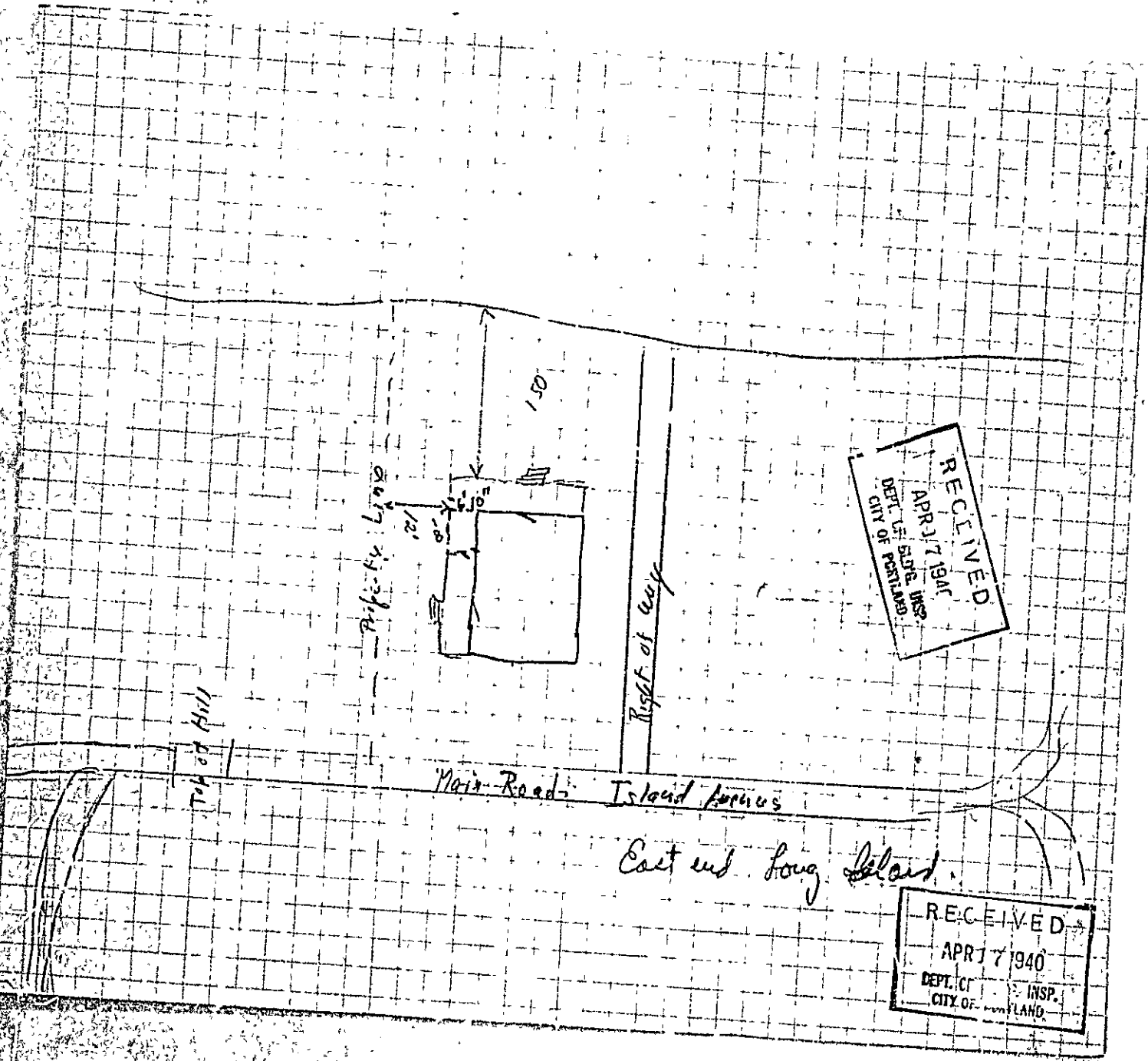
Will you please mail to me, in the enclosed envelope, a permit to make the following addition to my cottage located at the east end of Long Island.
